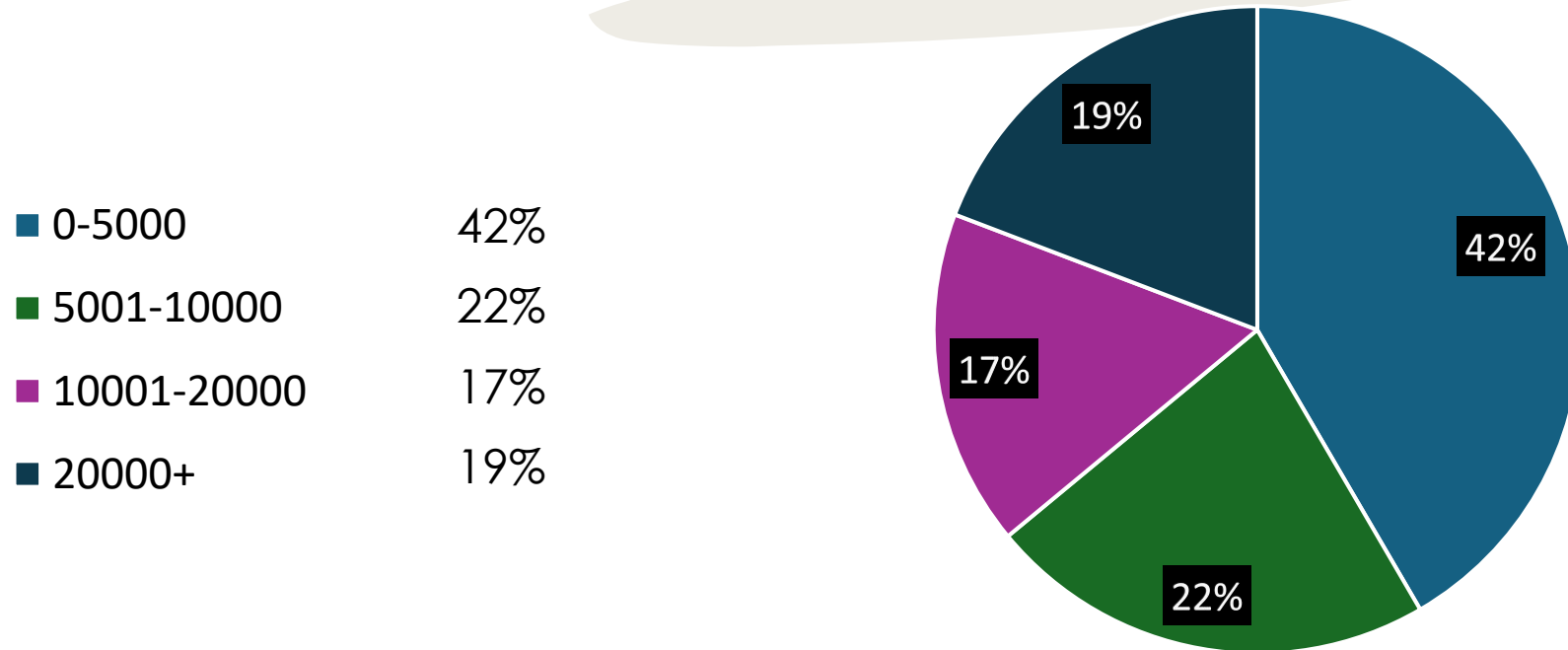

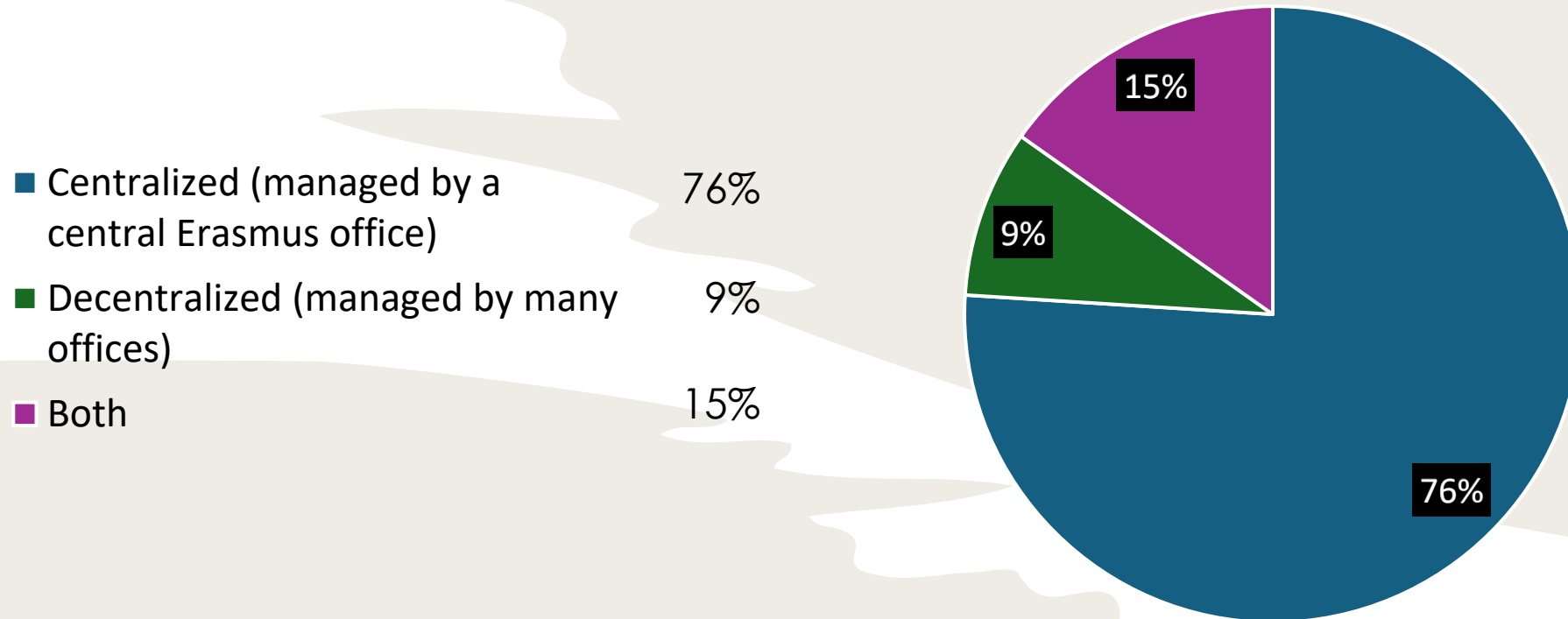
Registered number of students in the academic year 2022-2023



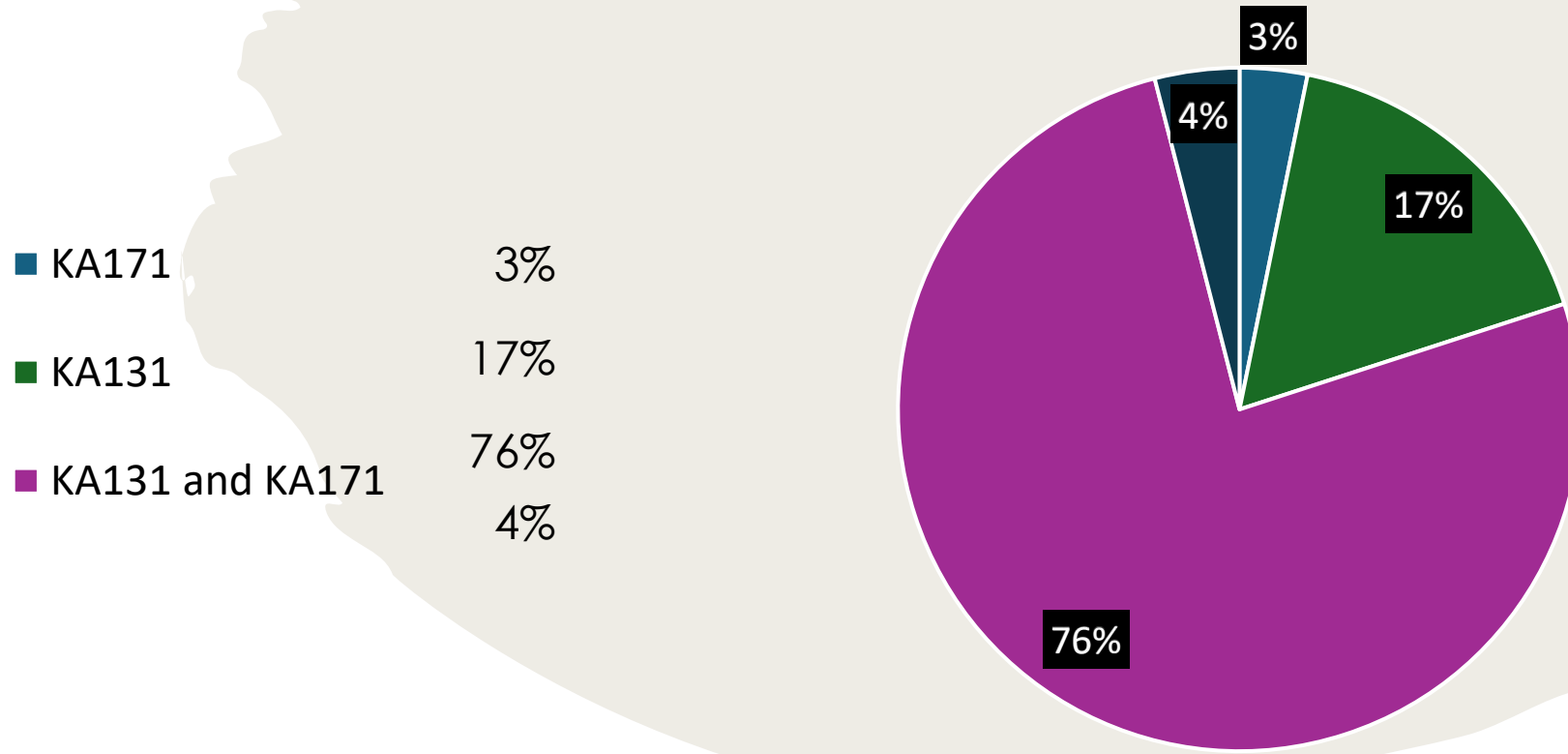

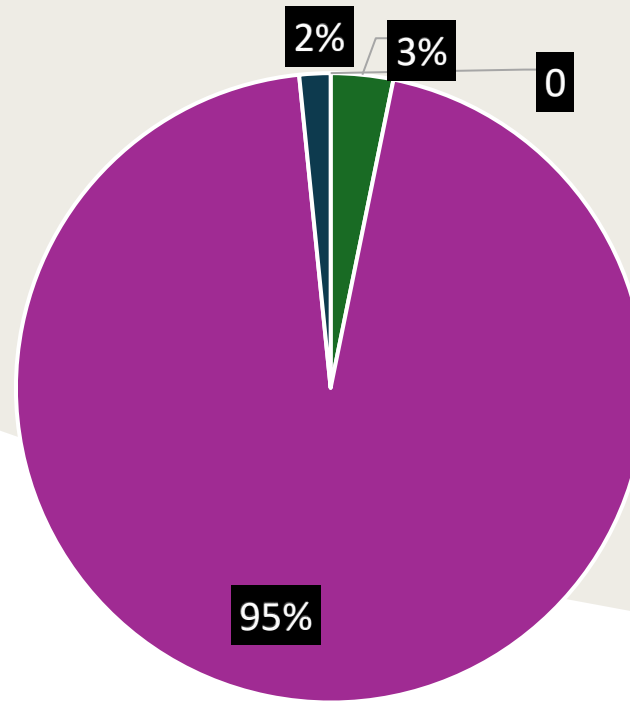

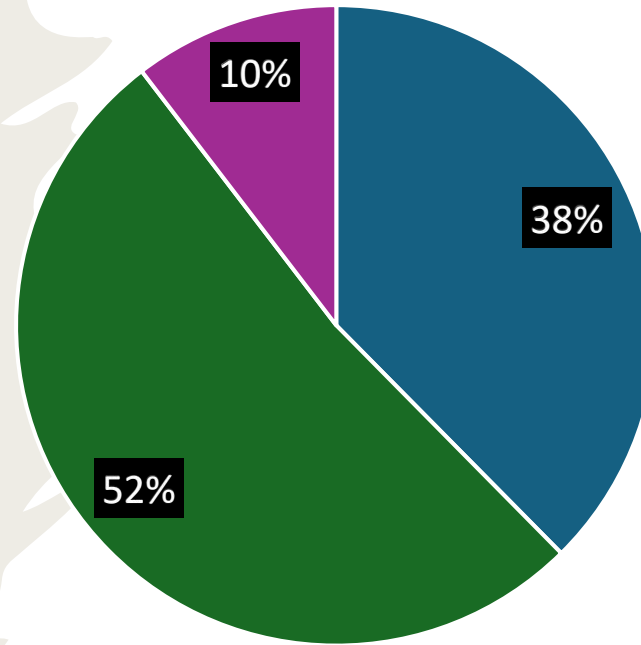

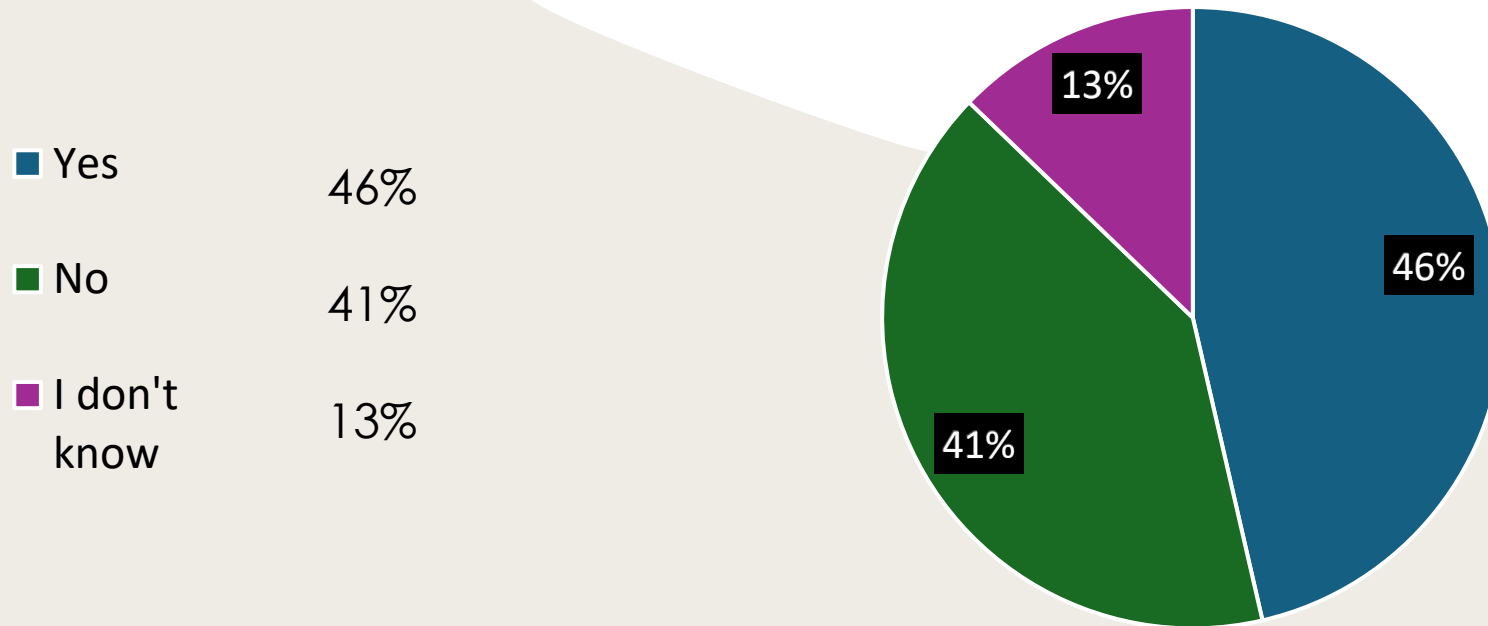

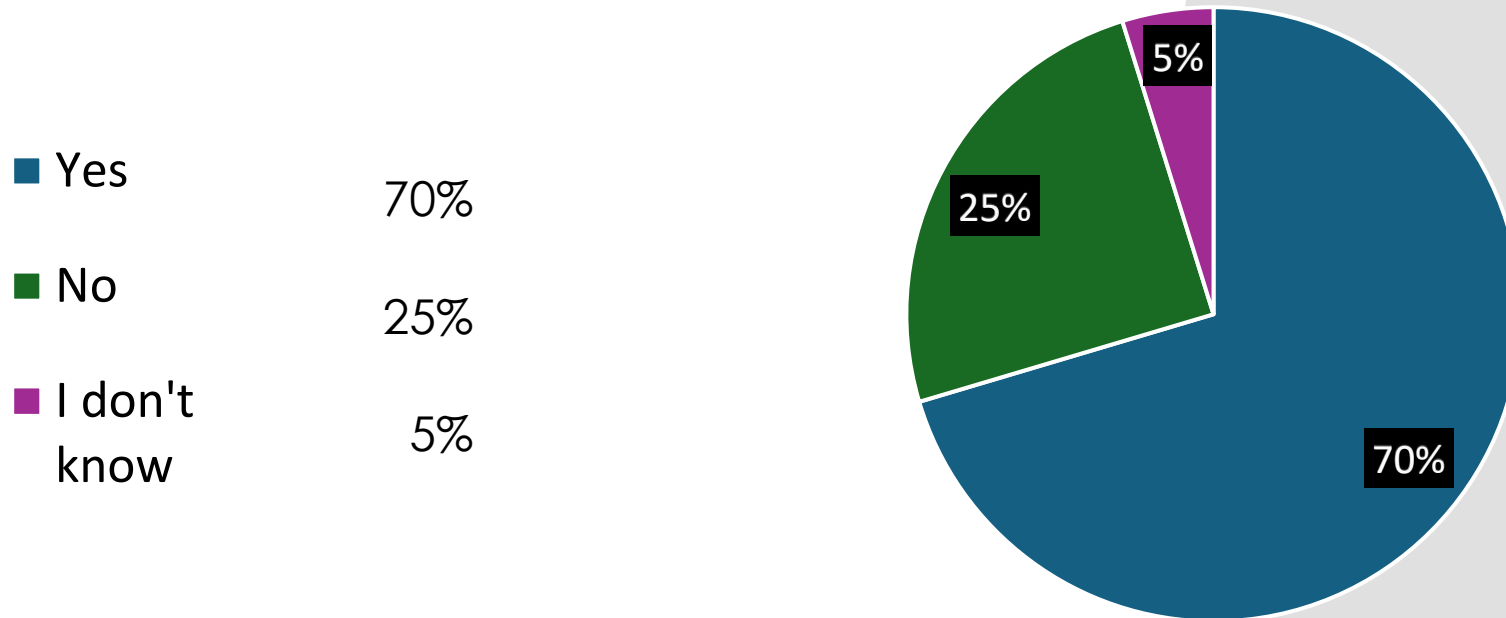

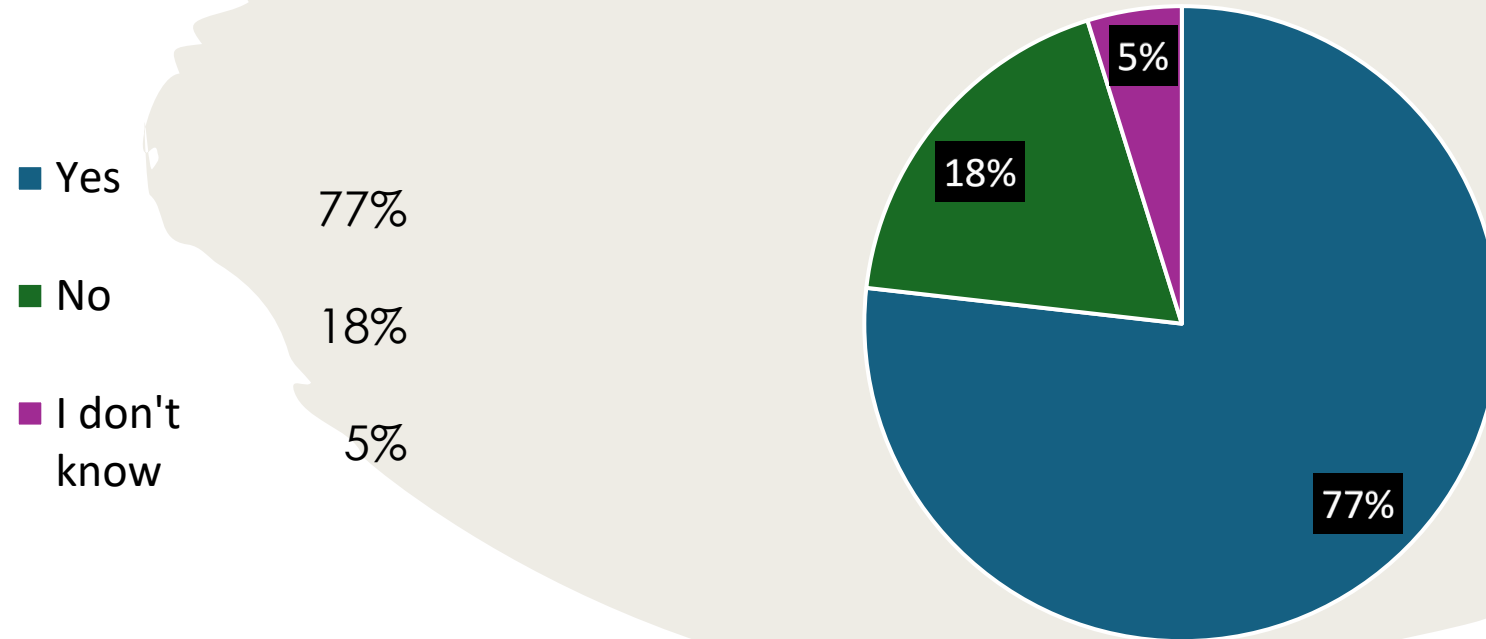
Do you have dedicated offices or staff in your HEI working to ensure inclusion and diversity in mobility?



Do you promote Erasmus+ mobility specifically to new staff/faculty members?

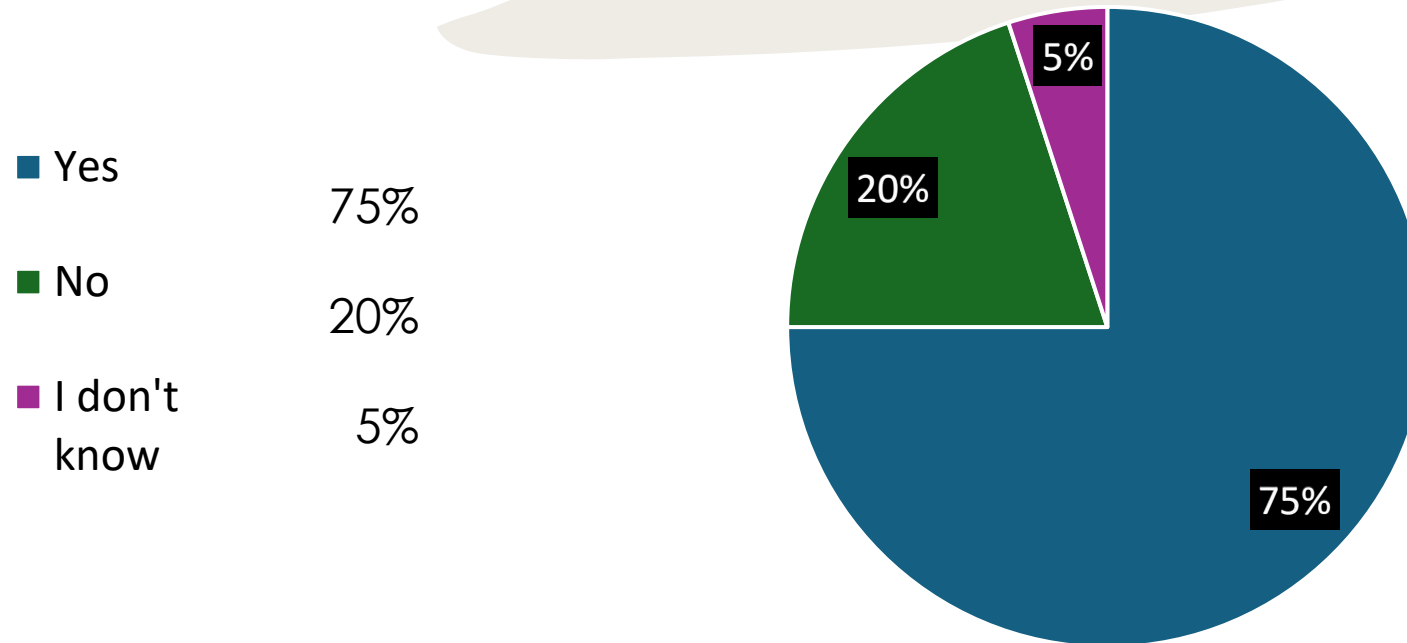


Do you actively promote Erasmus+ to students with fewer opportunities?

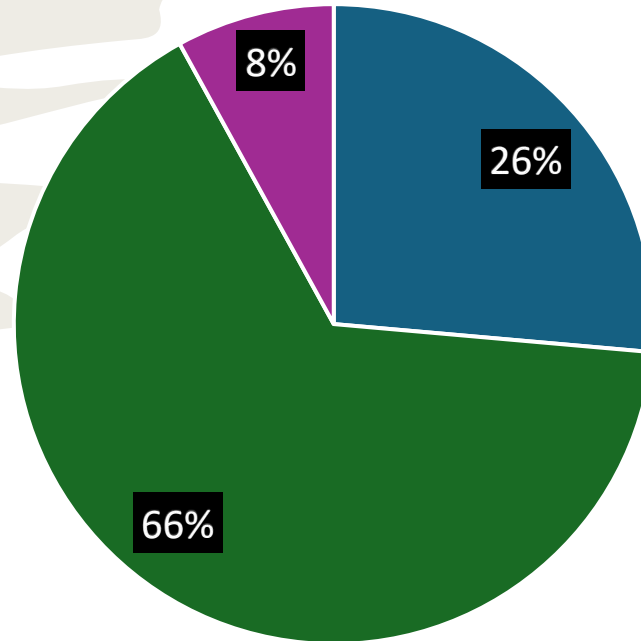

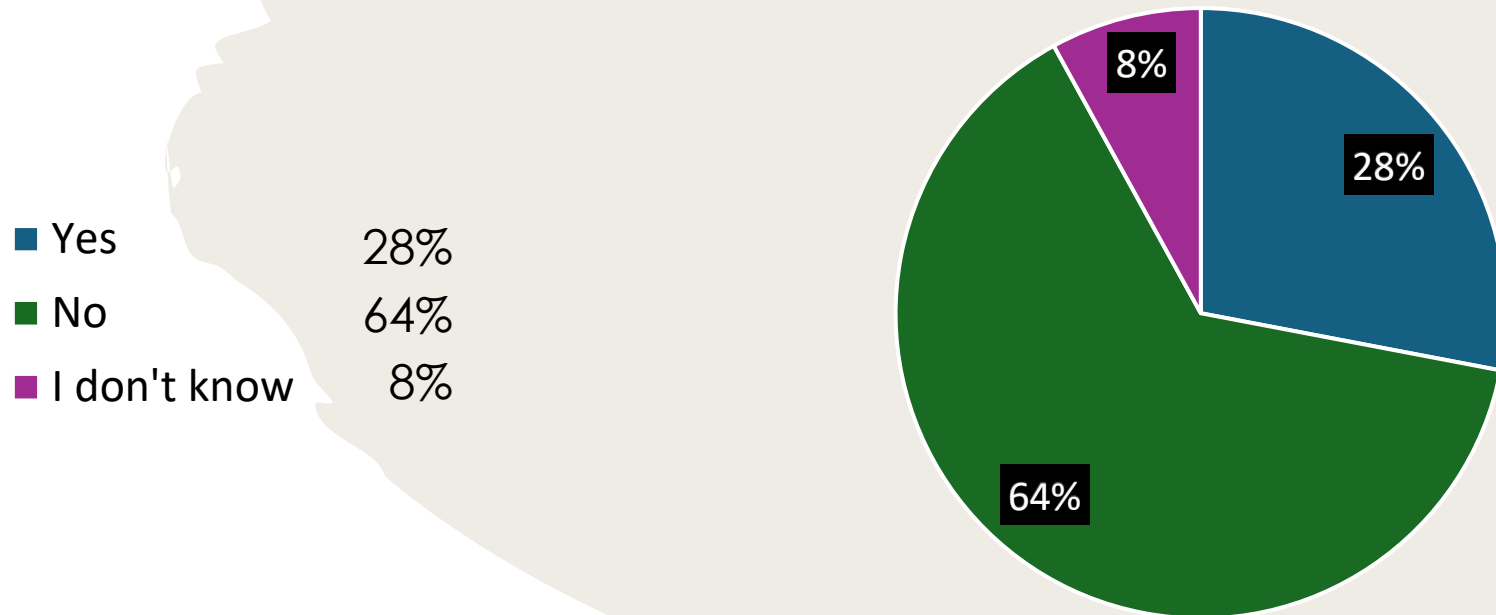

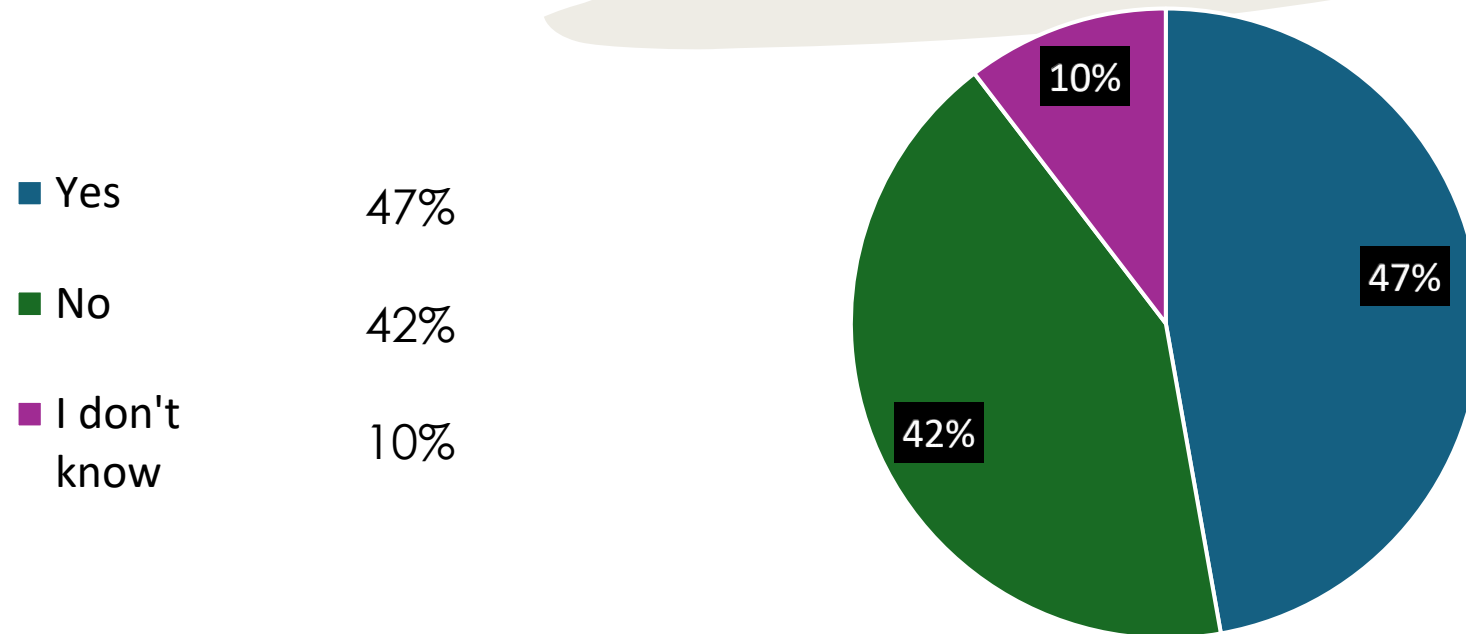

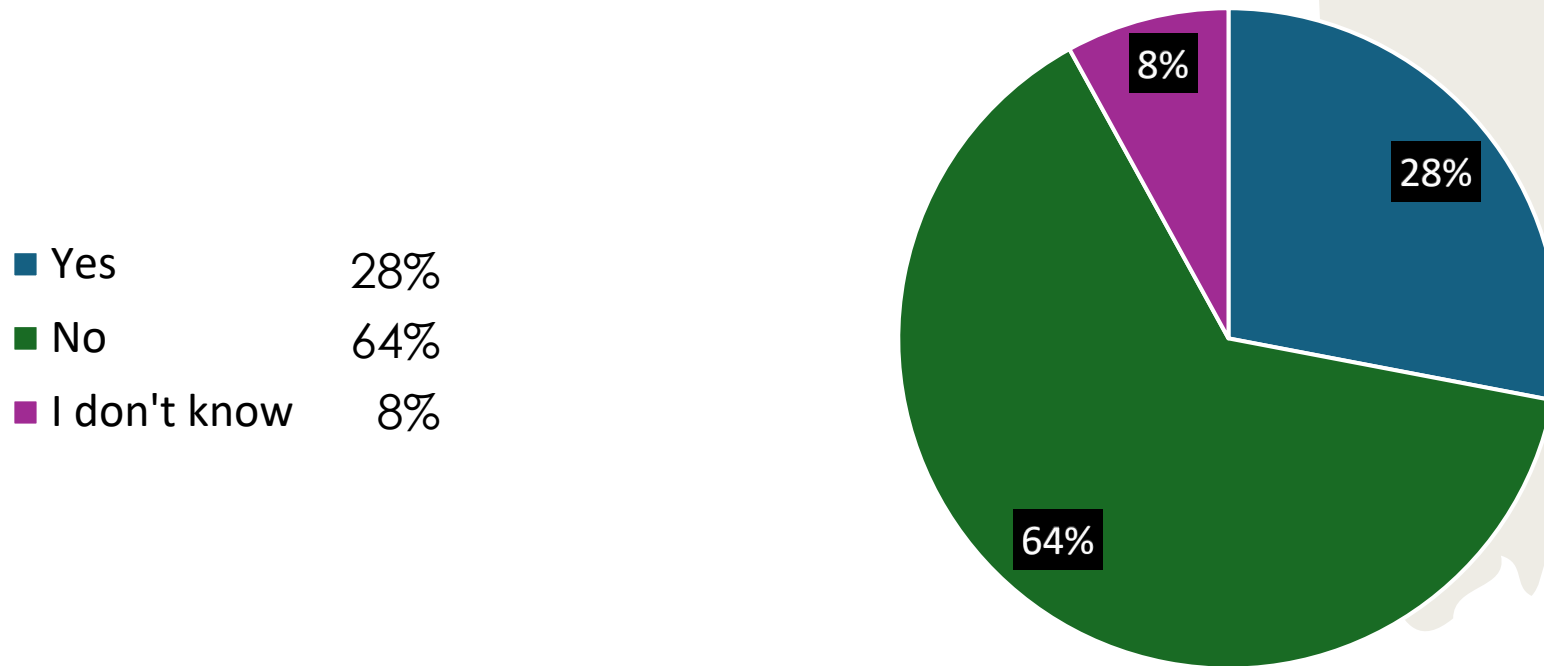


Do you promote the new short term doctoral student mobility opportunities?

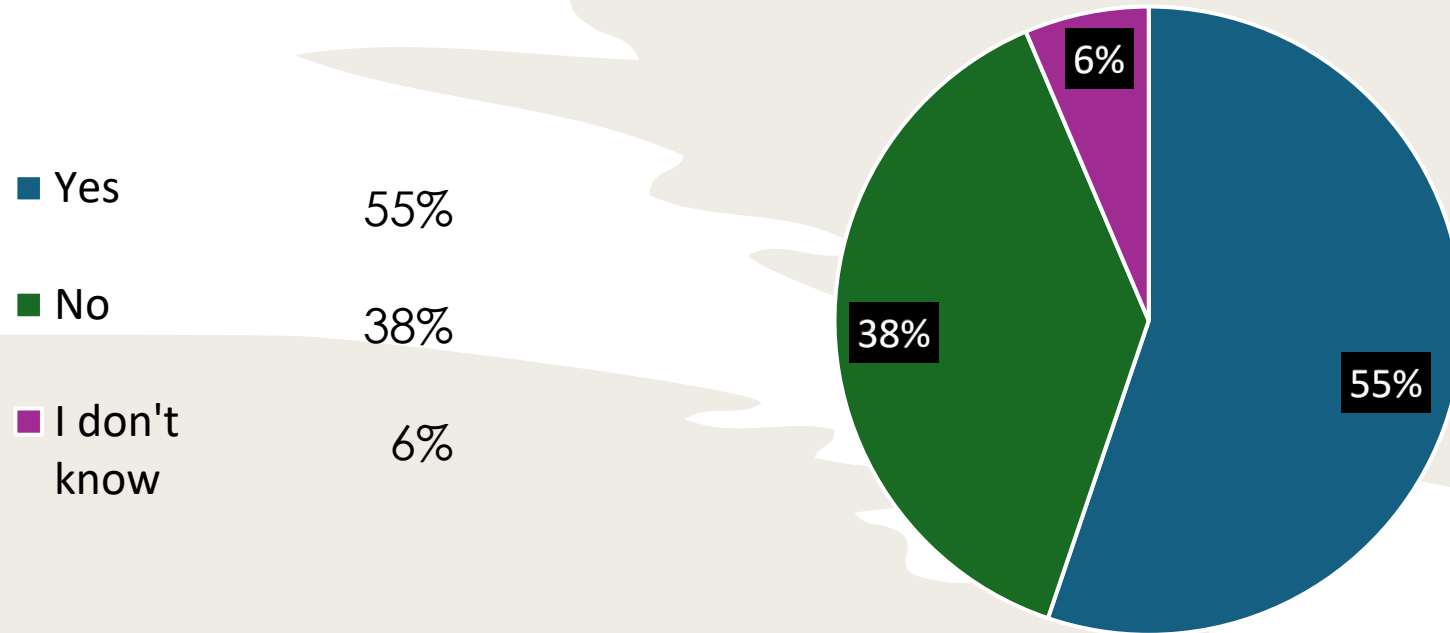

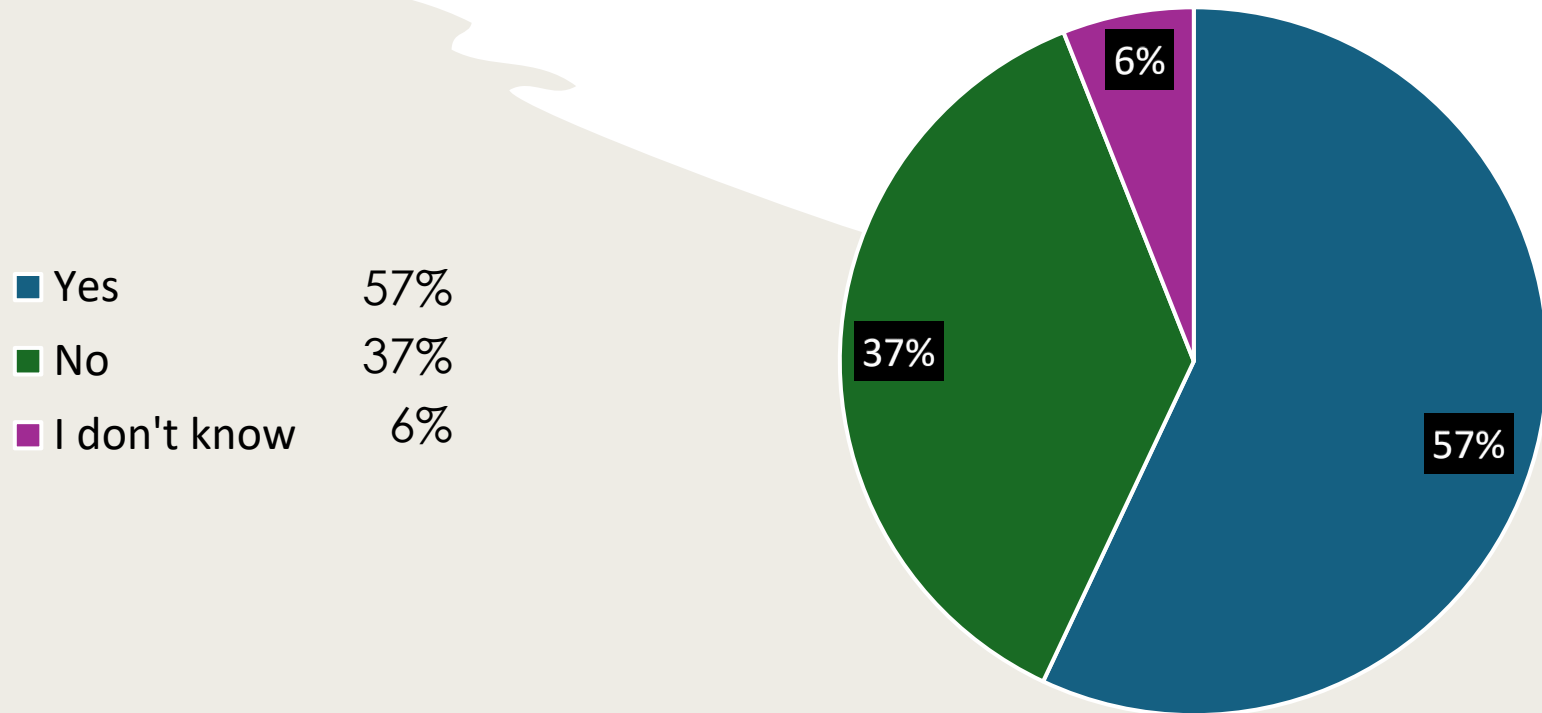


Do you promote the new Short term blended mobility?

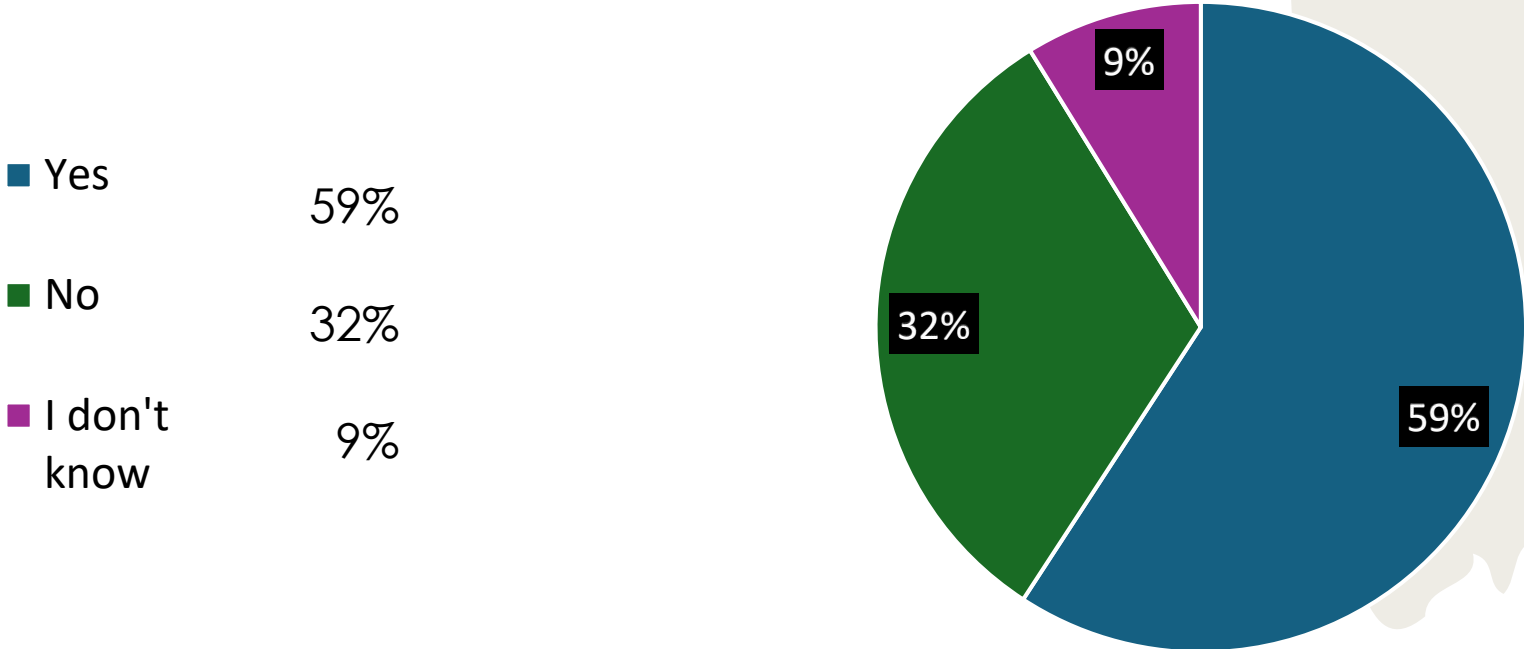

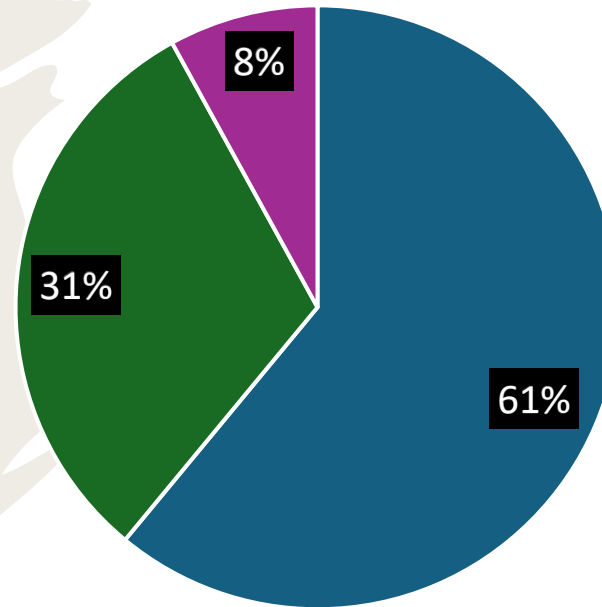
Do you promote the new Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes, BIP's?



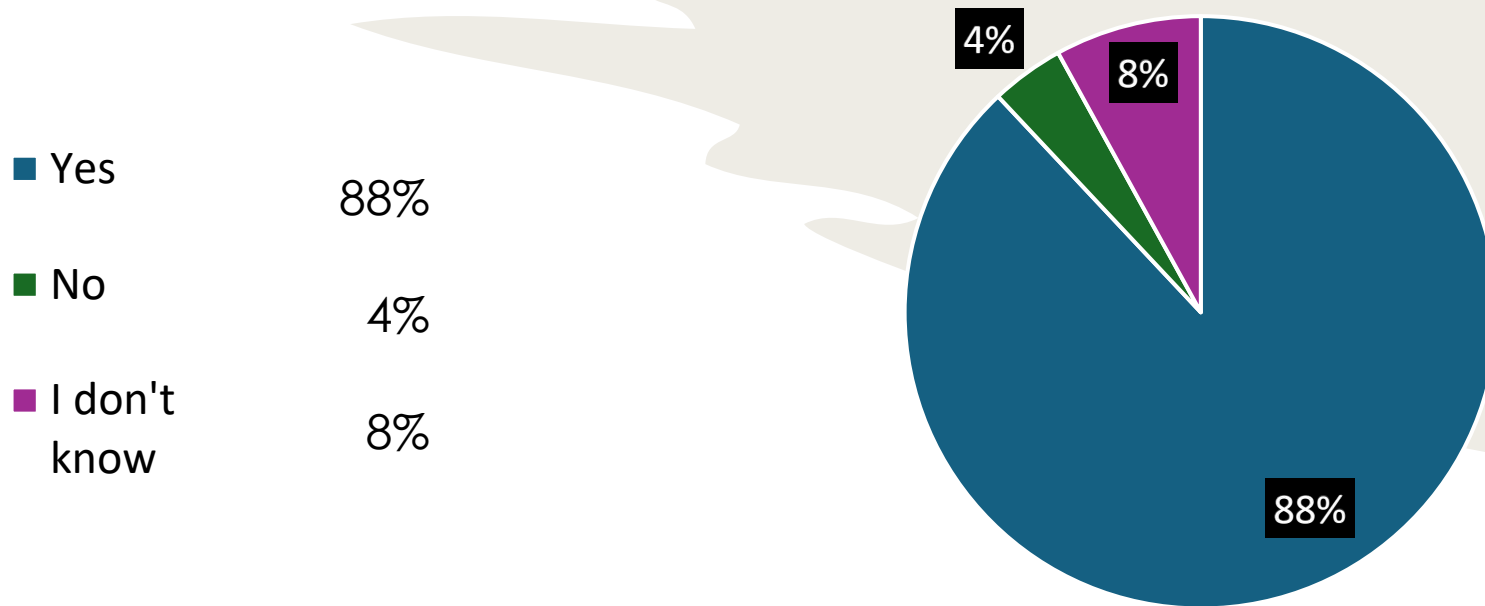

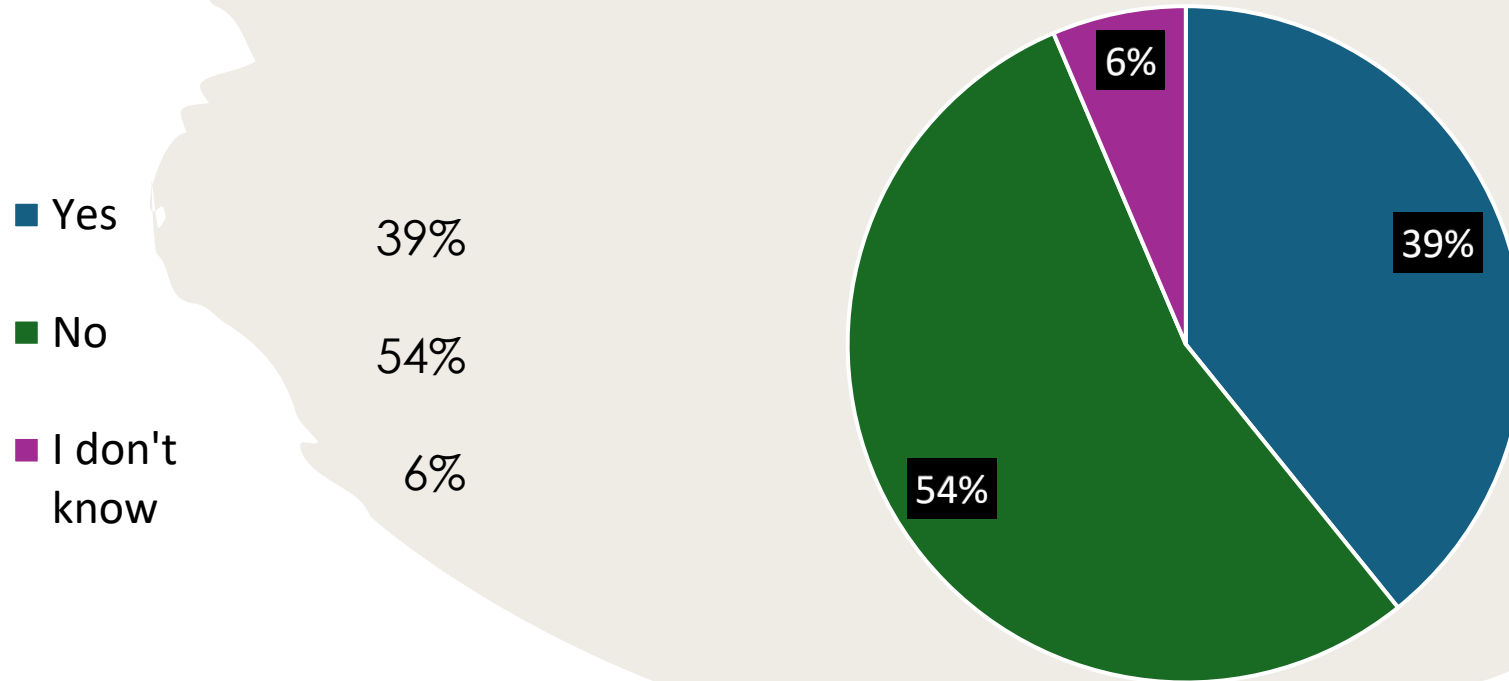
Do you give the "Erasmus Student Charter" to your students so that they know their rights and responsibilities?



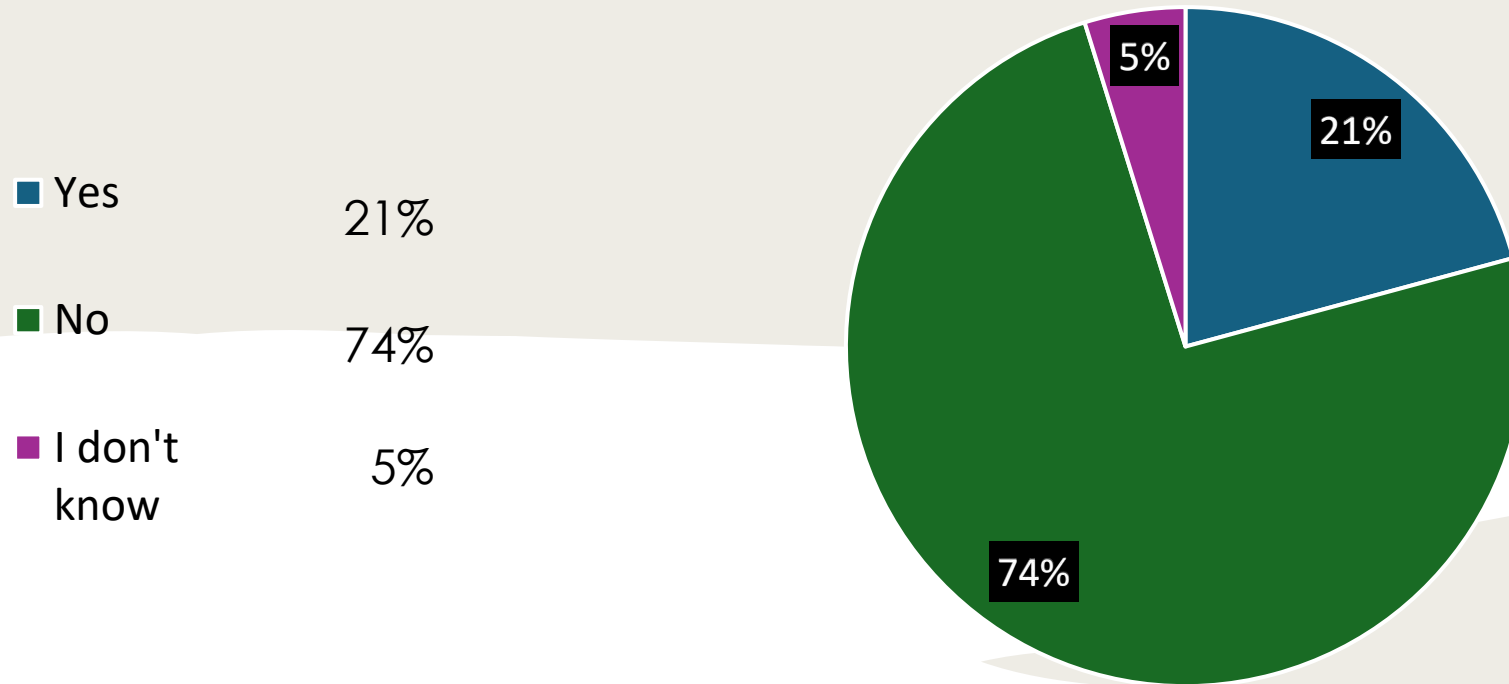

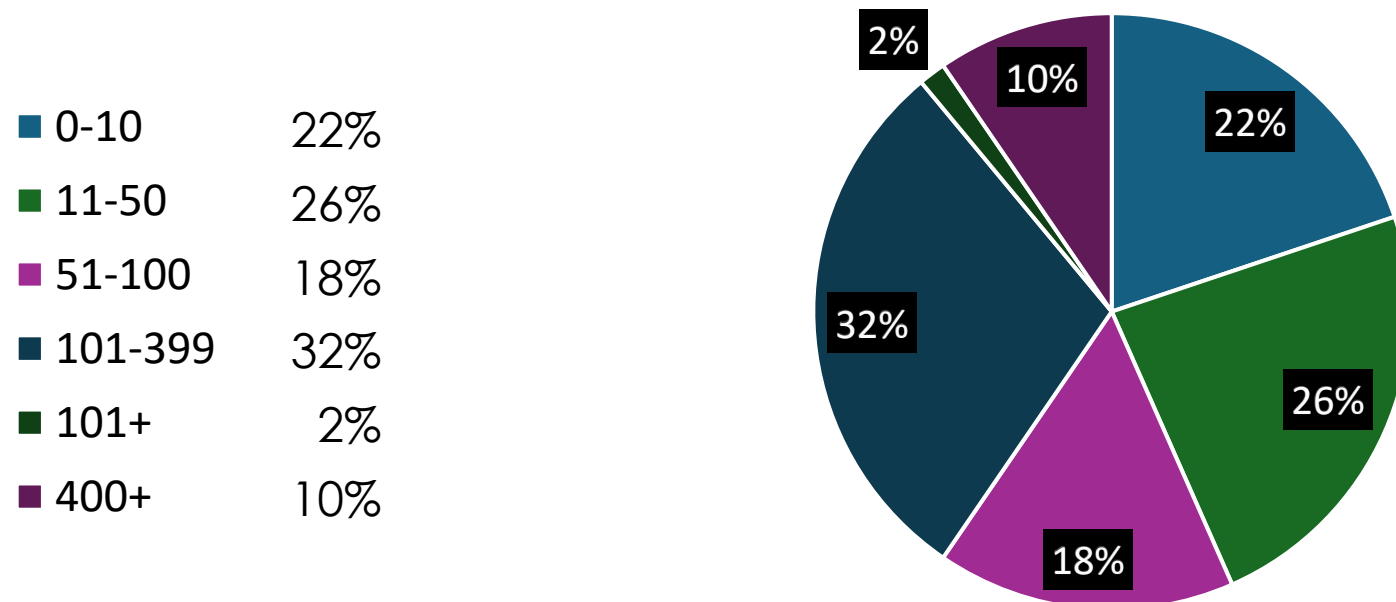
Does your institution have mobility windows, (a period of mobility embedded into the curriculum of a study program)?

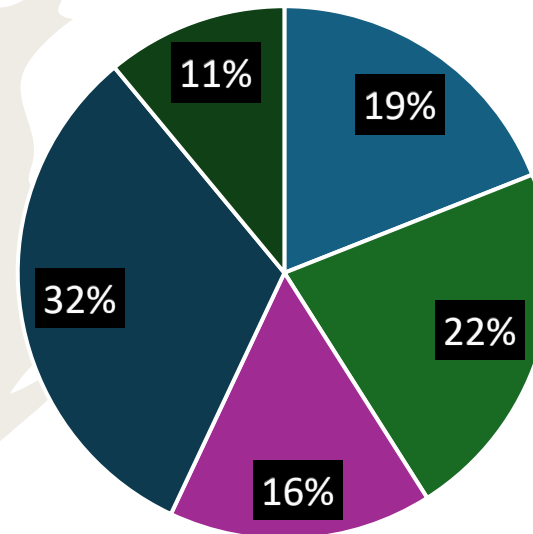
What is the number of realized Erasmus outgoing student mobilities at your institution, in the academic year 2022-2023, including the summer of 2023?

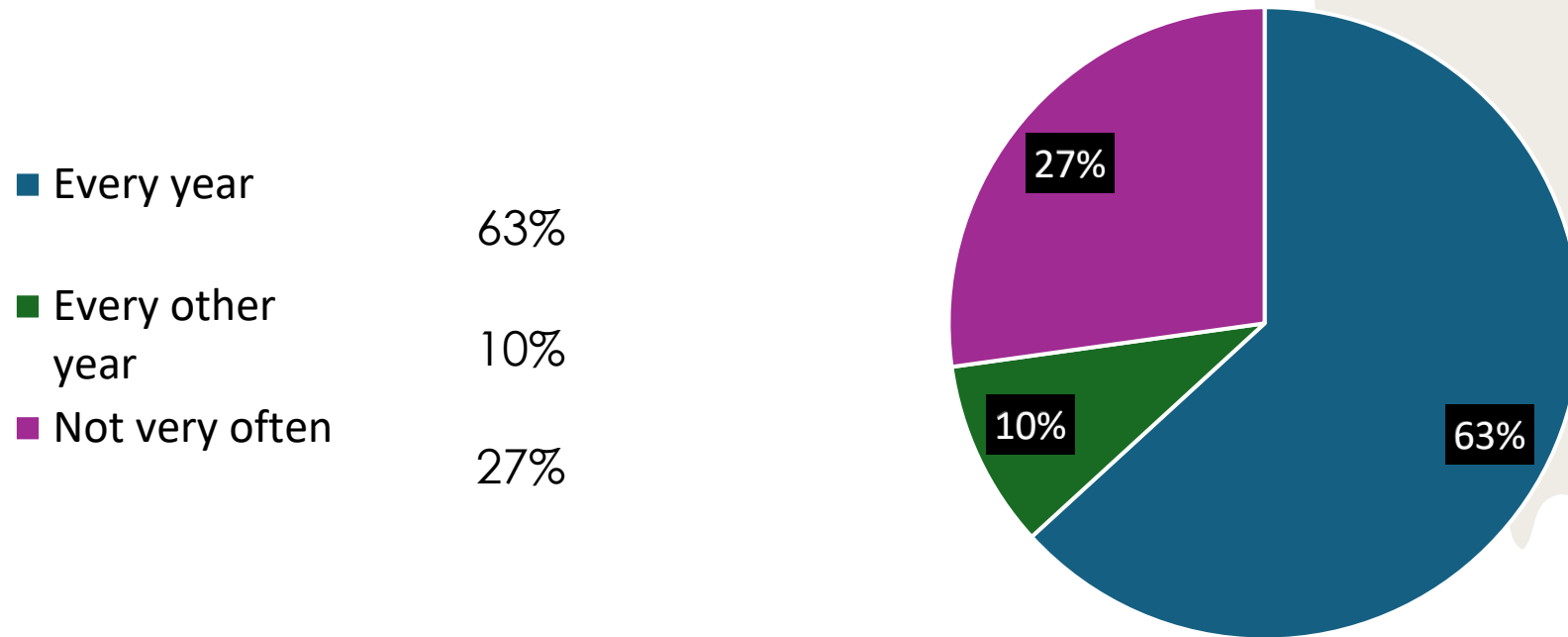

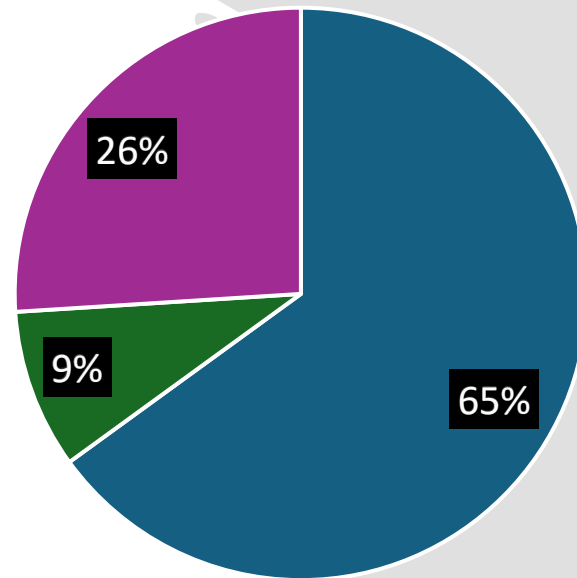
How often do you sign new Erasmus+ Inter-Institutional agreements, with partner country institutions for outgoing mobilities (funding under KA131)?



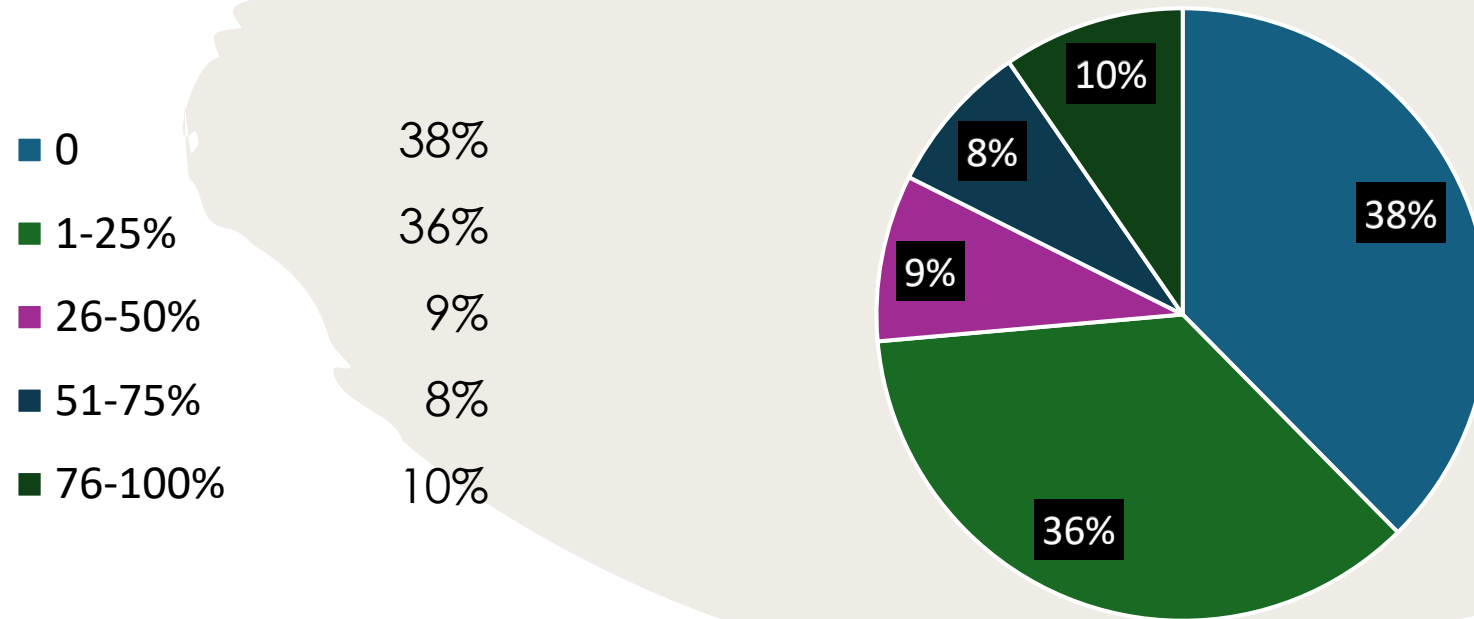

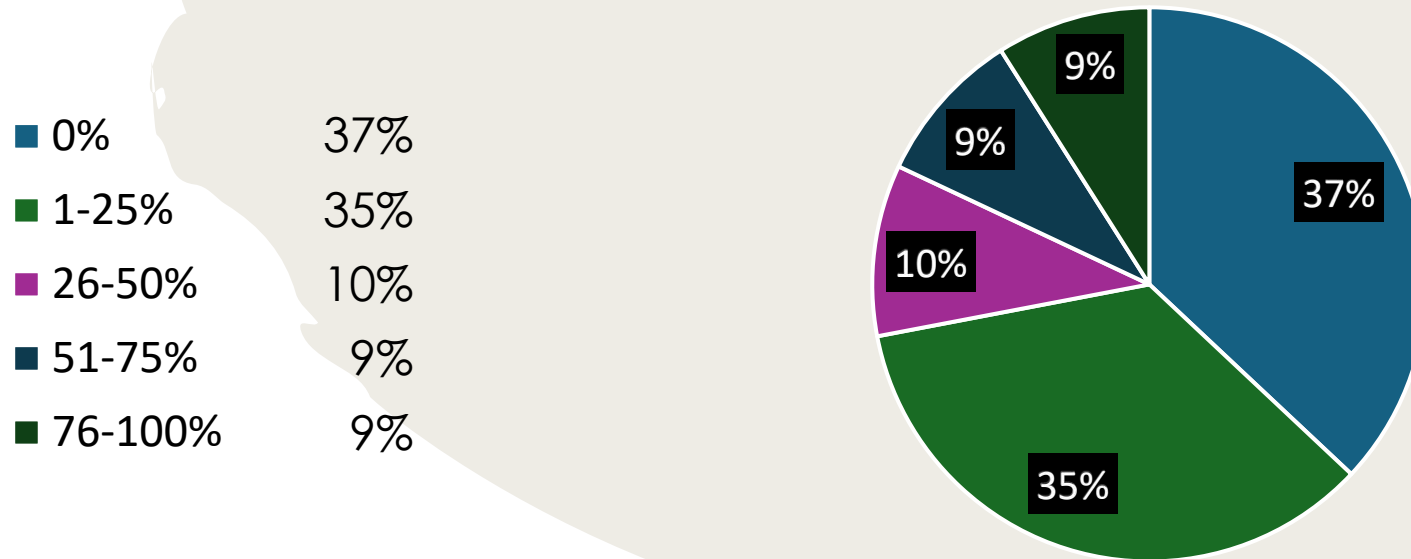


How much of the 20% allowable budget in the 2022 Call did you absorb for KA131 international mobility in 2022-2023, including the summer of 2023?

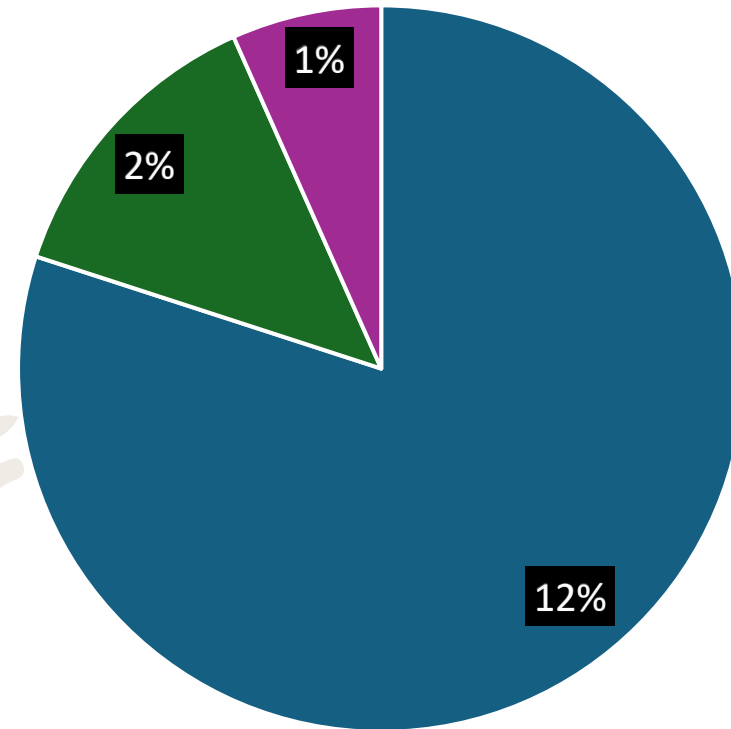



Which are the 3 most favorite countries for outgoing Erasmus international student mobility, within KA131?

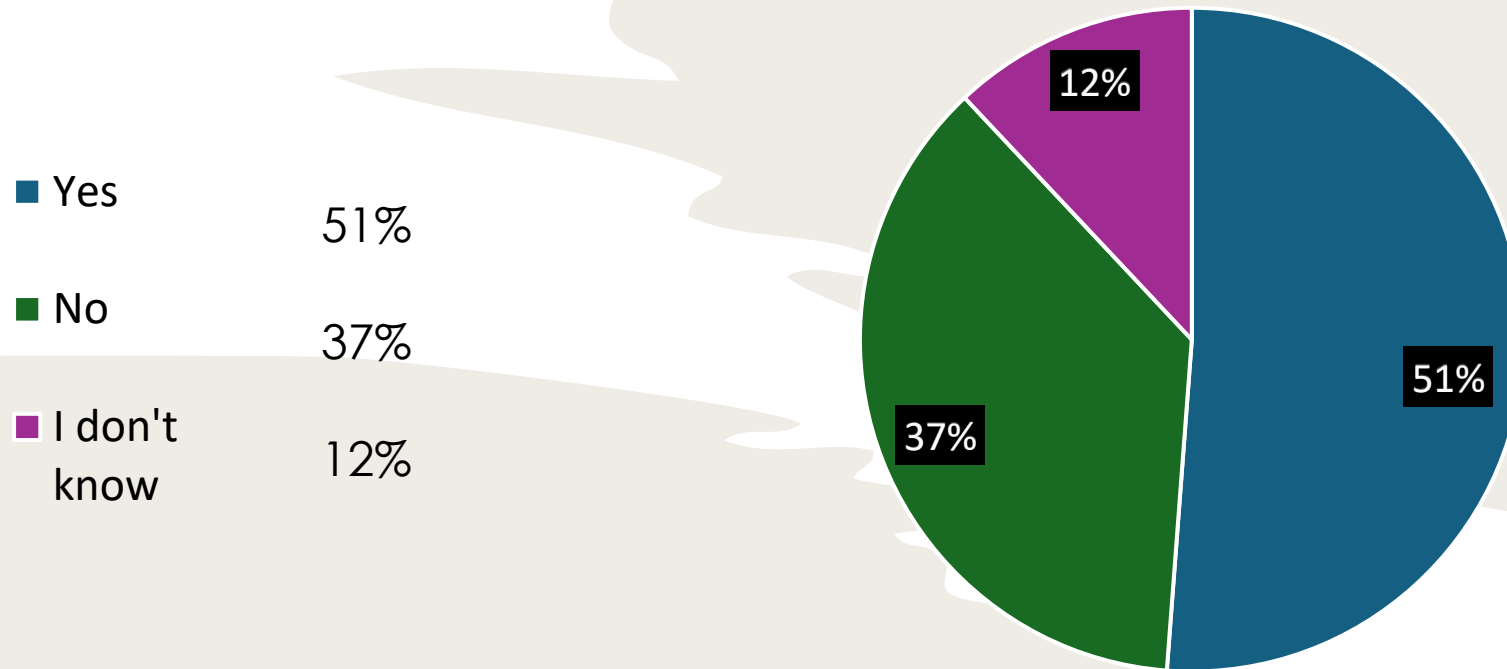

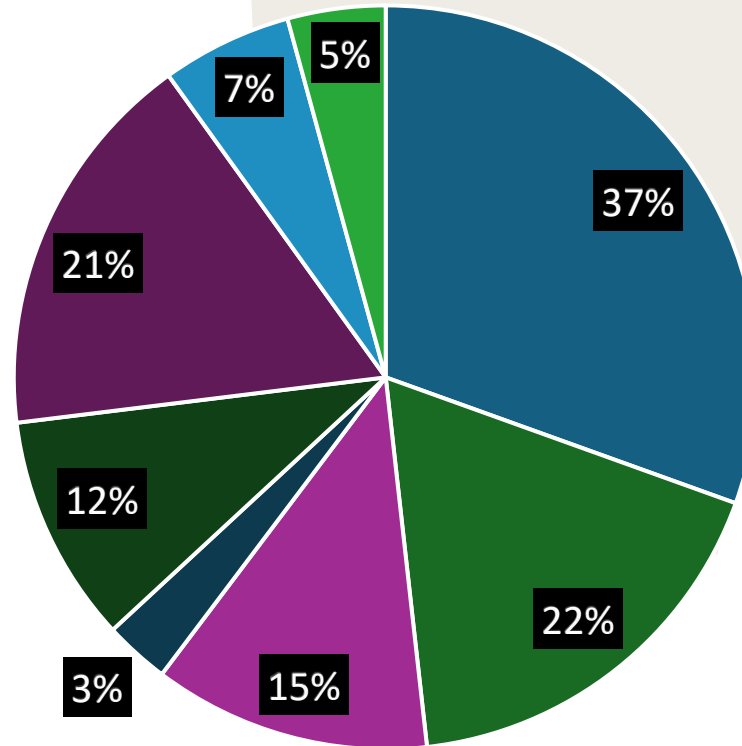

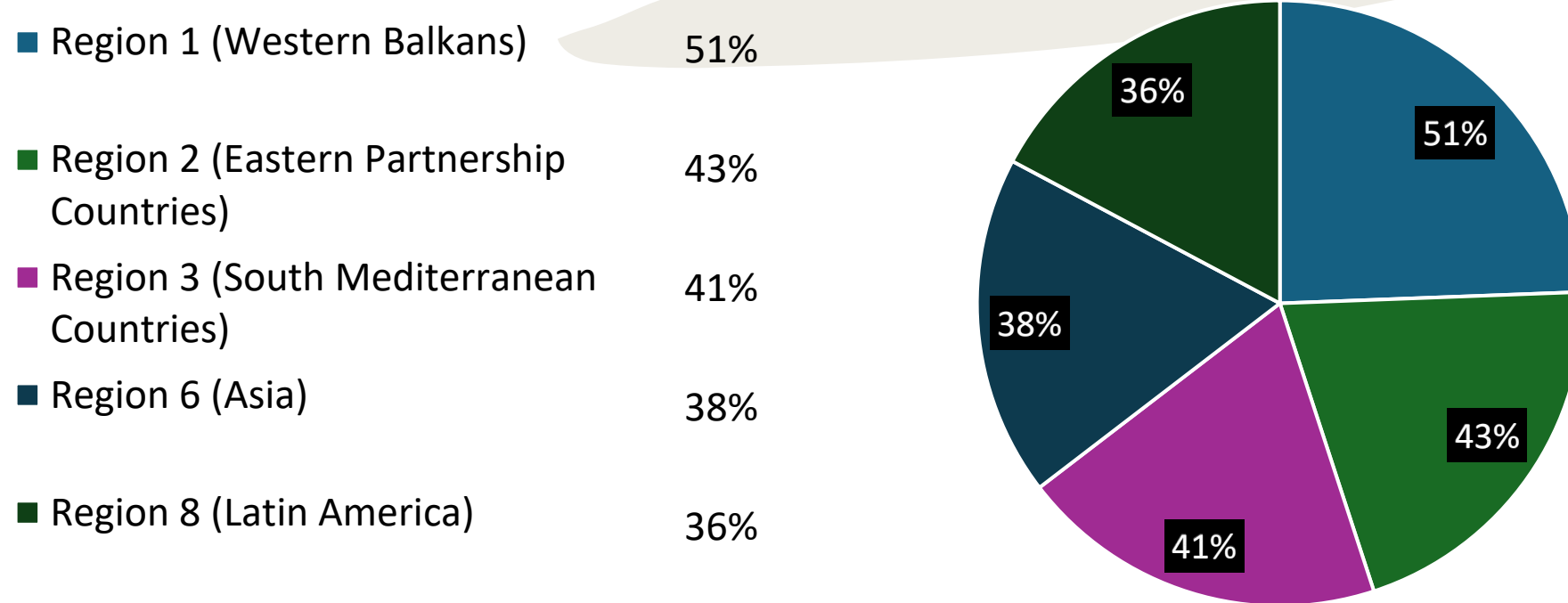

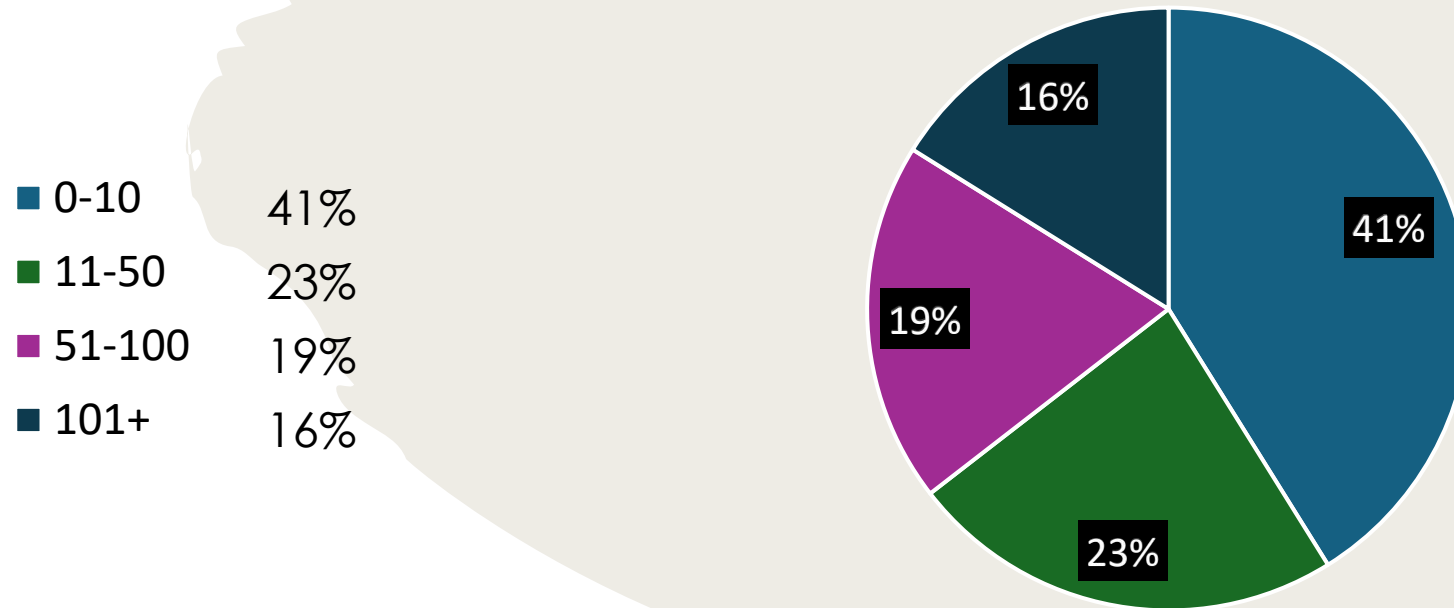

Which regions are the most relevant for you to cooperate with? (choose up to 3 regions)



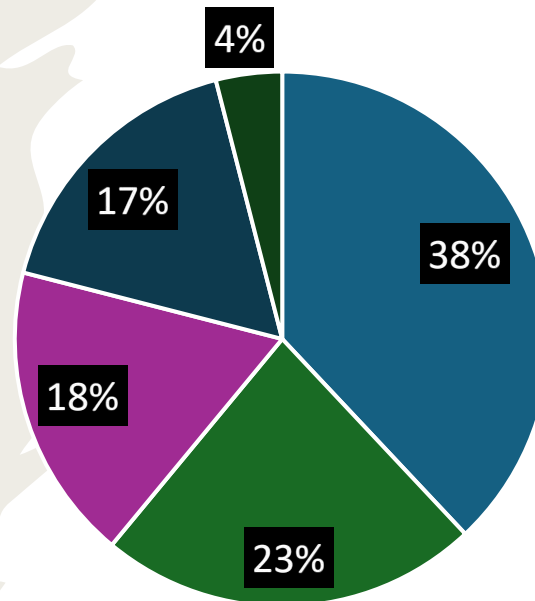

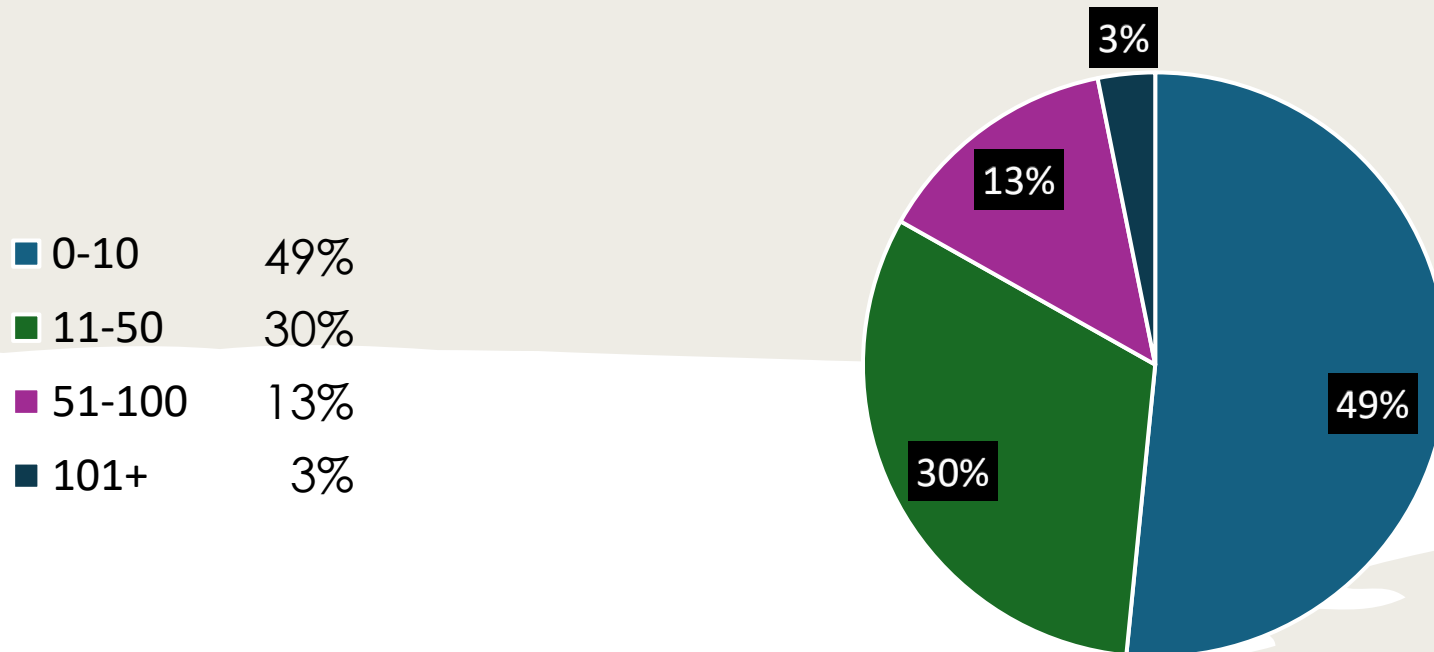

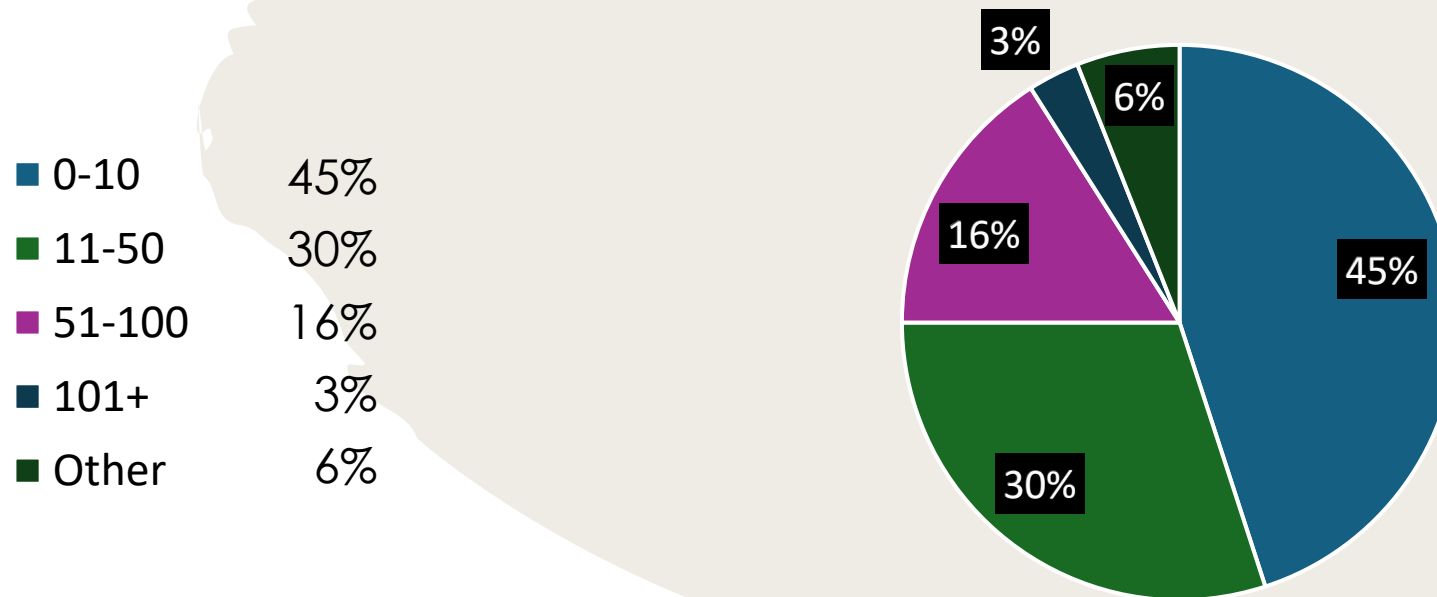


What is the number of realized Erasmus outgoing staff mobilities in ICM, in the academic year 2022-2023, including the summer of 2023 if applicable?



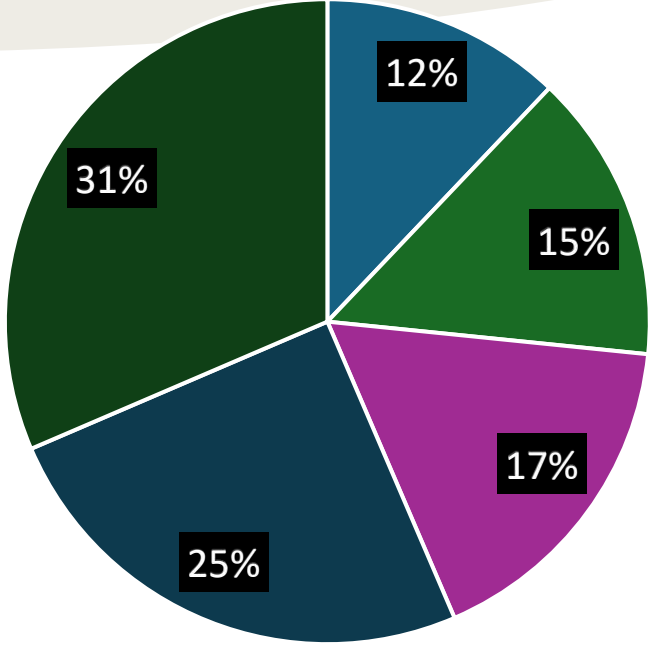

What percentage of funds was absorbed until September 2023 (2022, 2023 funding years) if applicable?

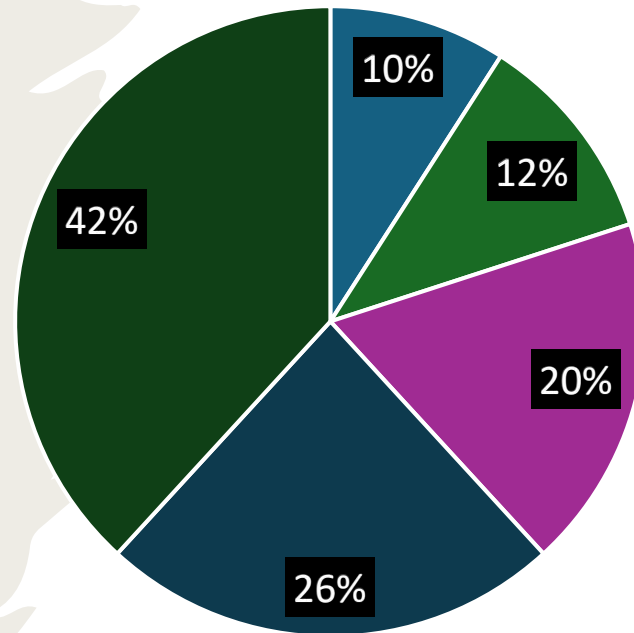

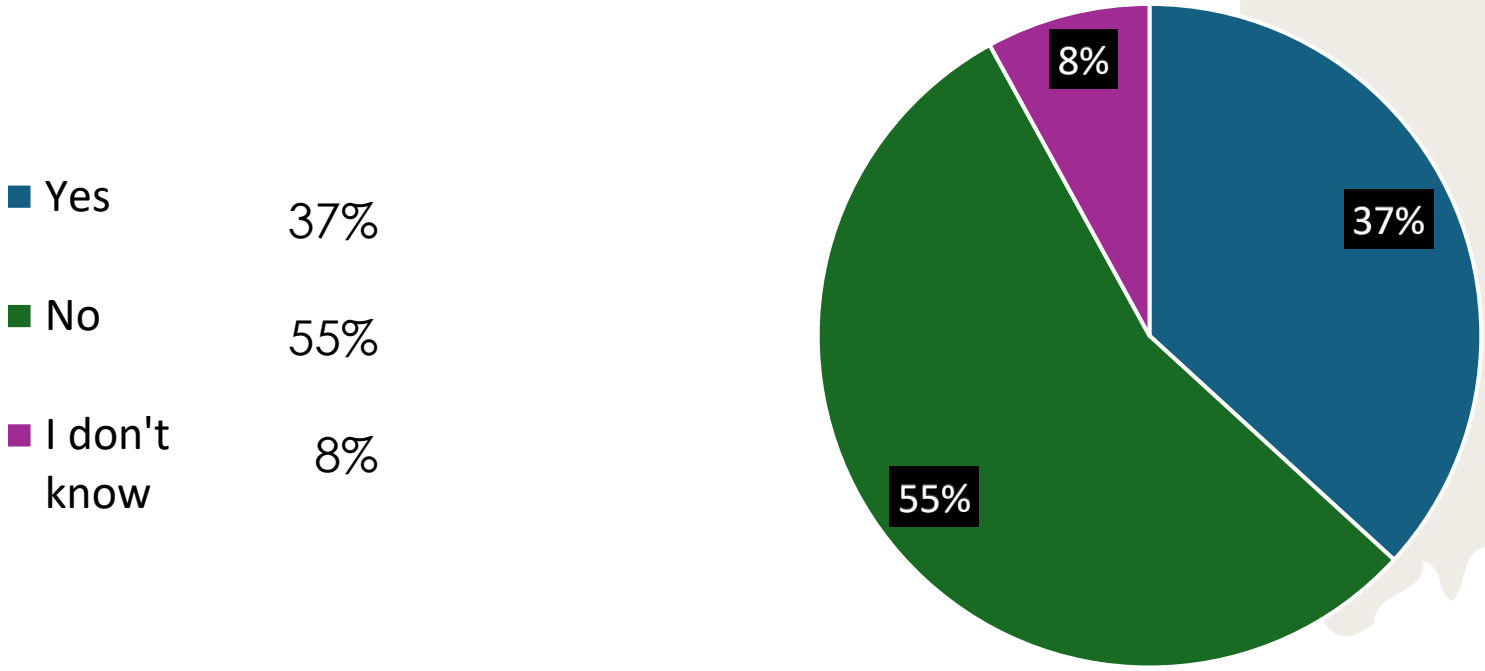

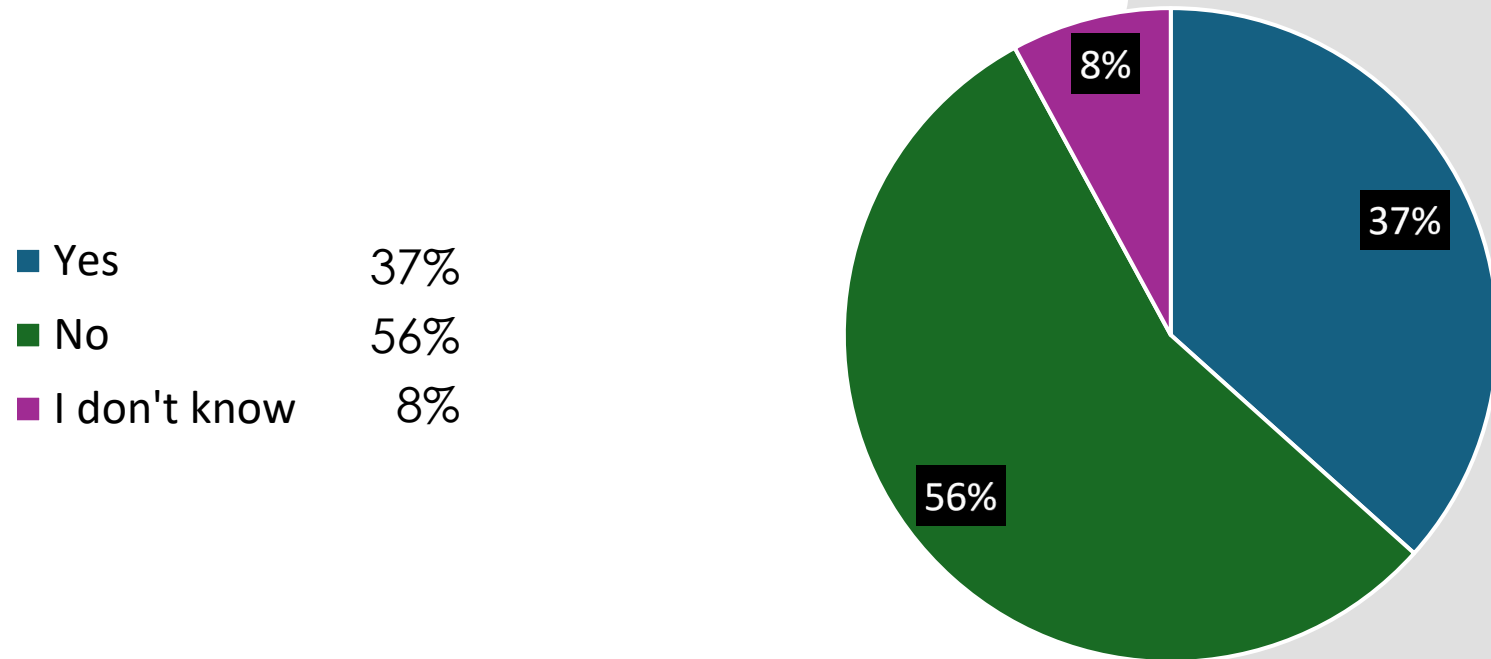

Does your institution organize blended courses for incoming students (Blended Intensive Programs BIPs or other)?

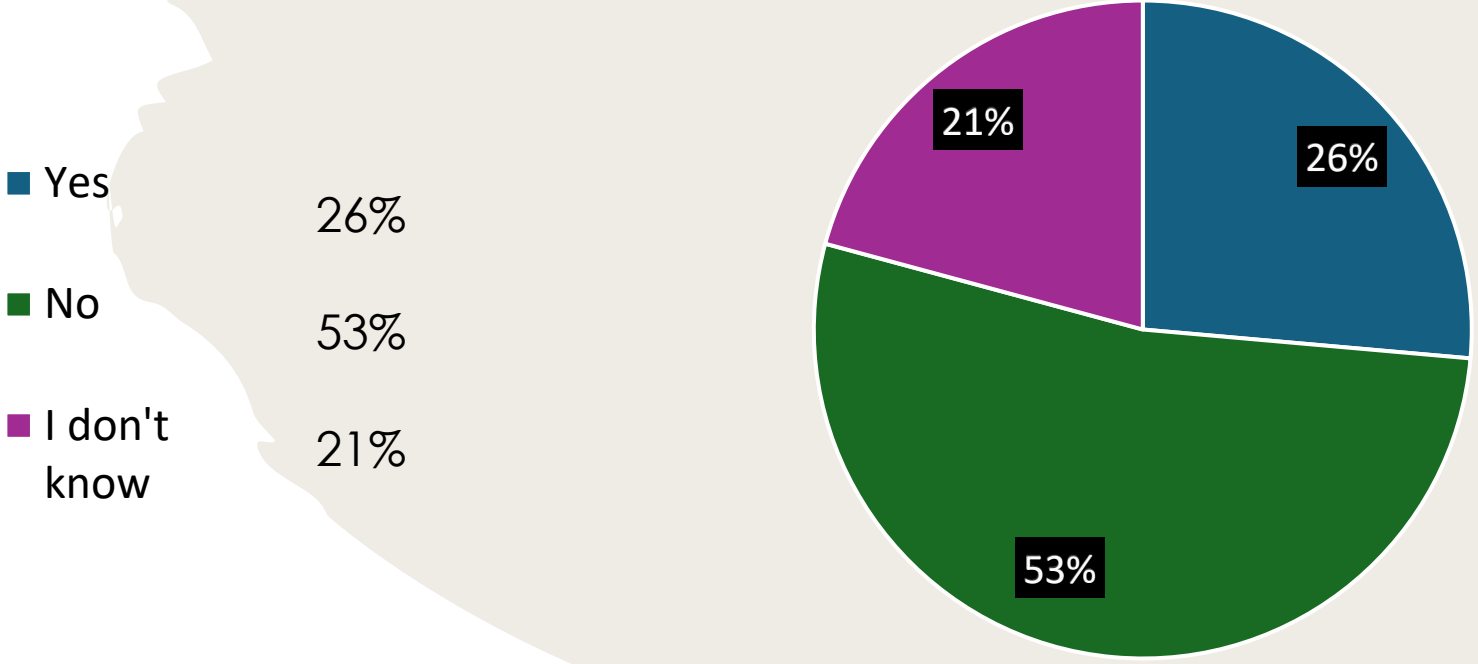

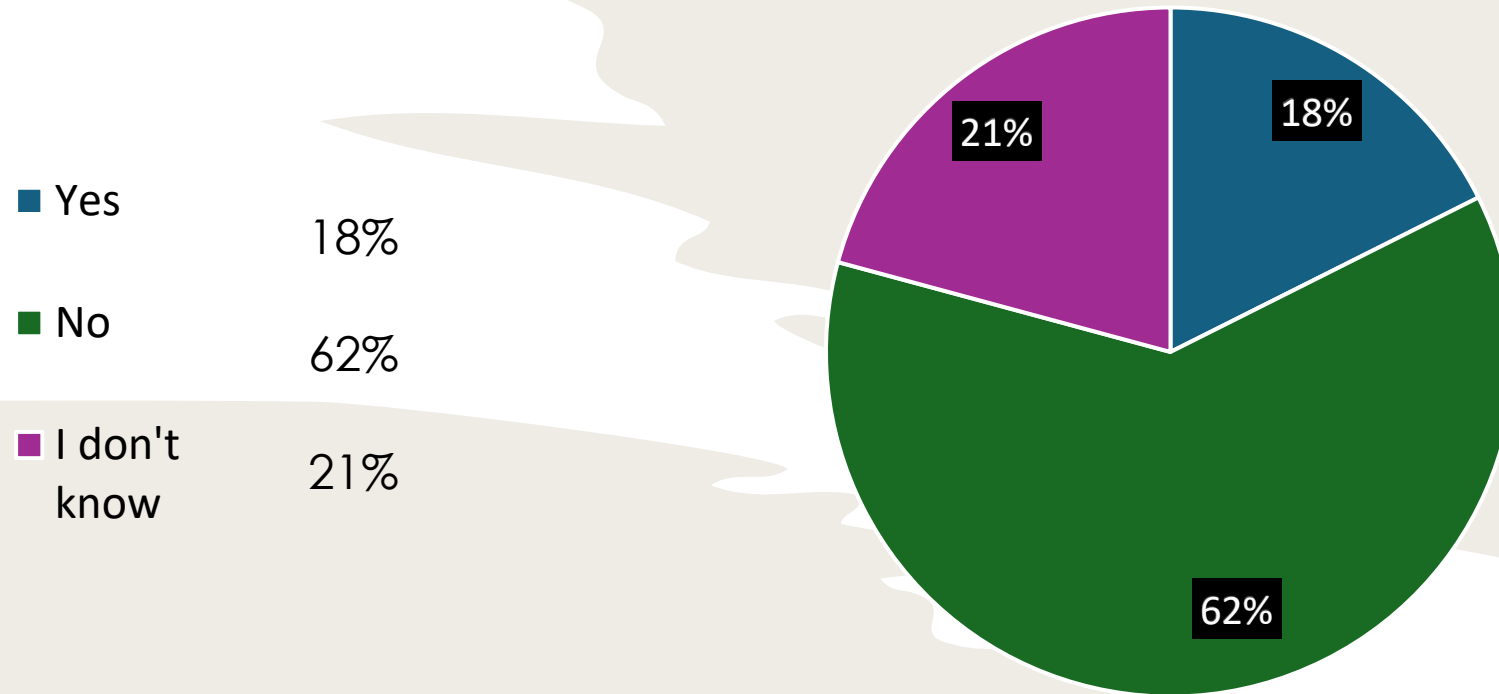

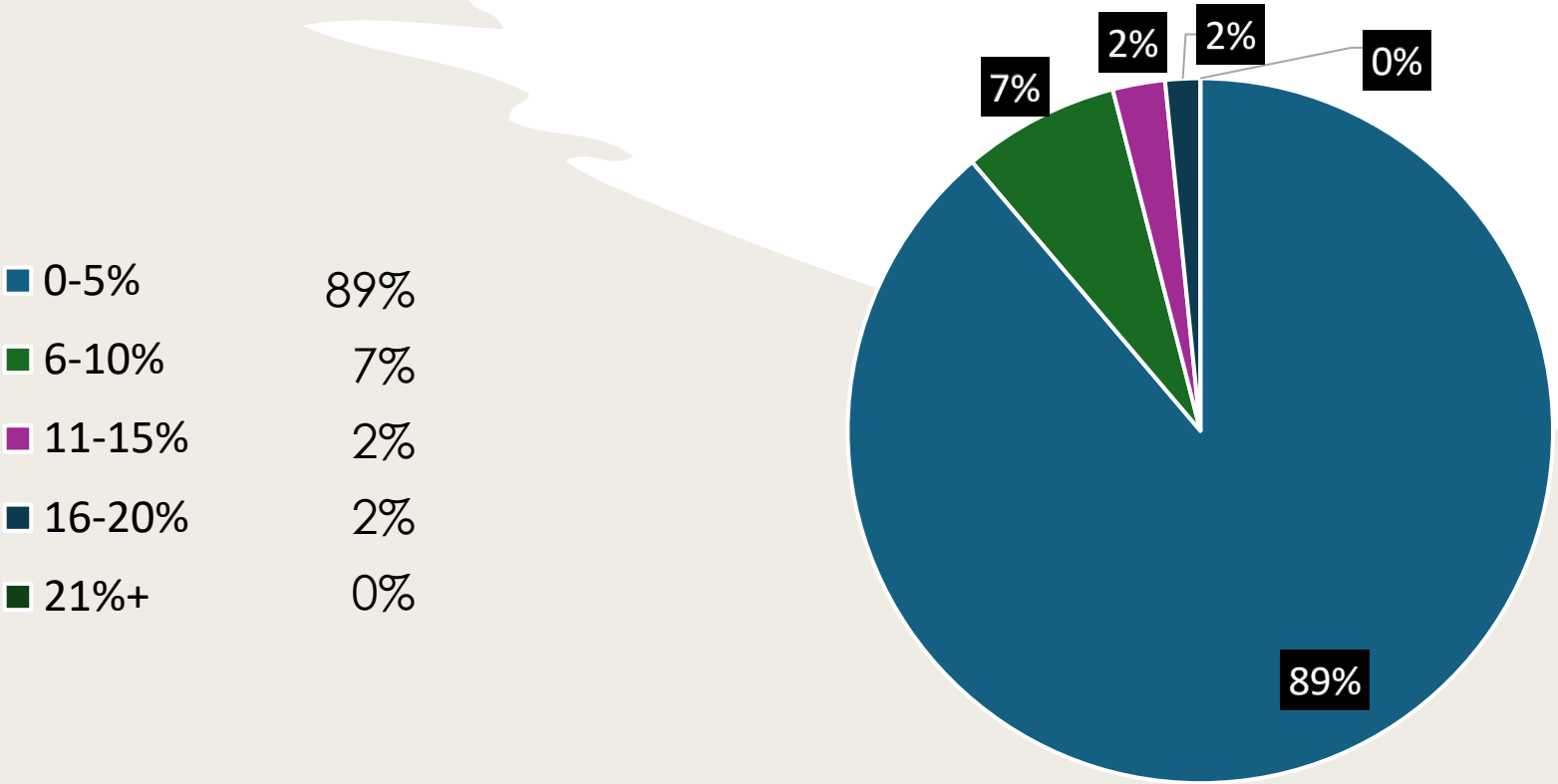
Is outgoing-blended mobility popular among your students?



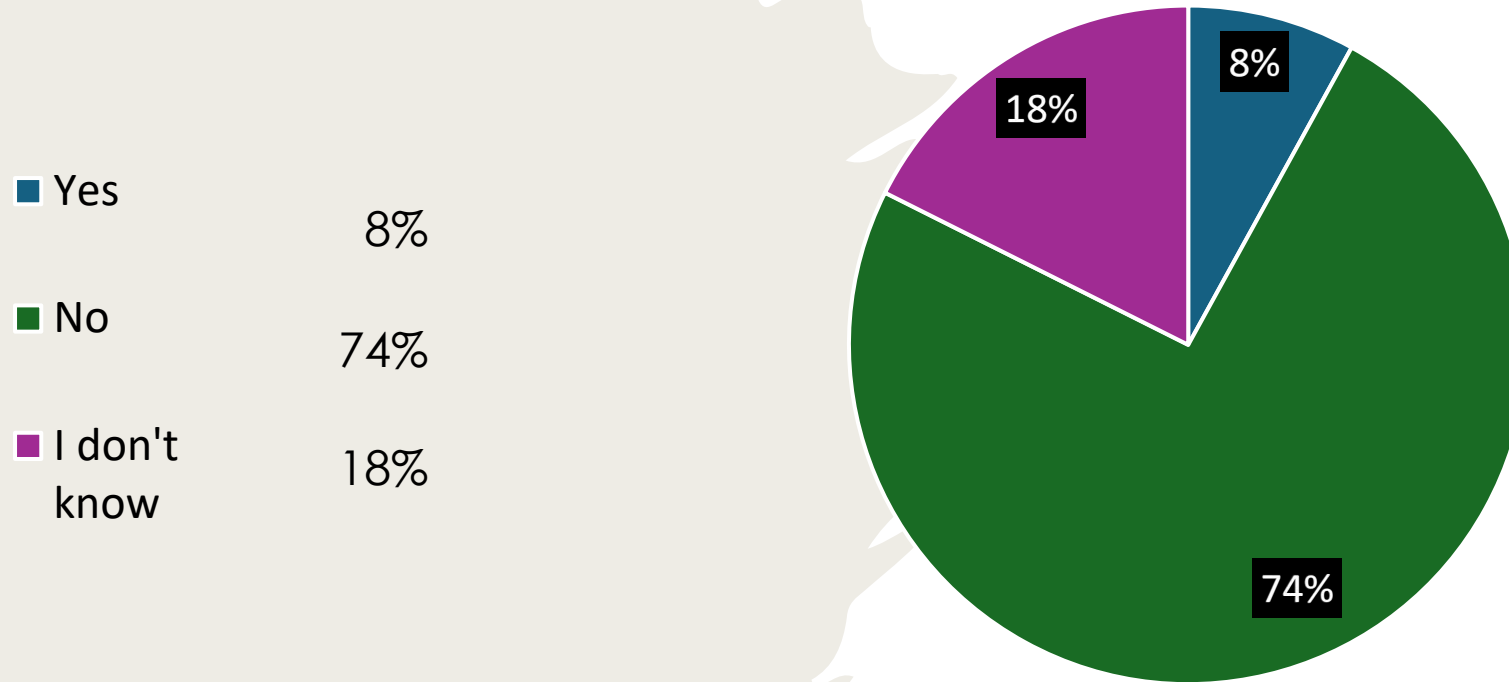
Is outgoing-blended mobility popular among your staff members?



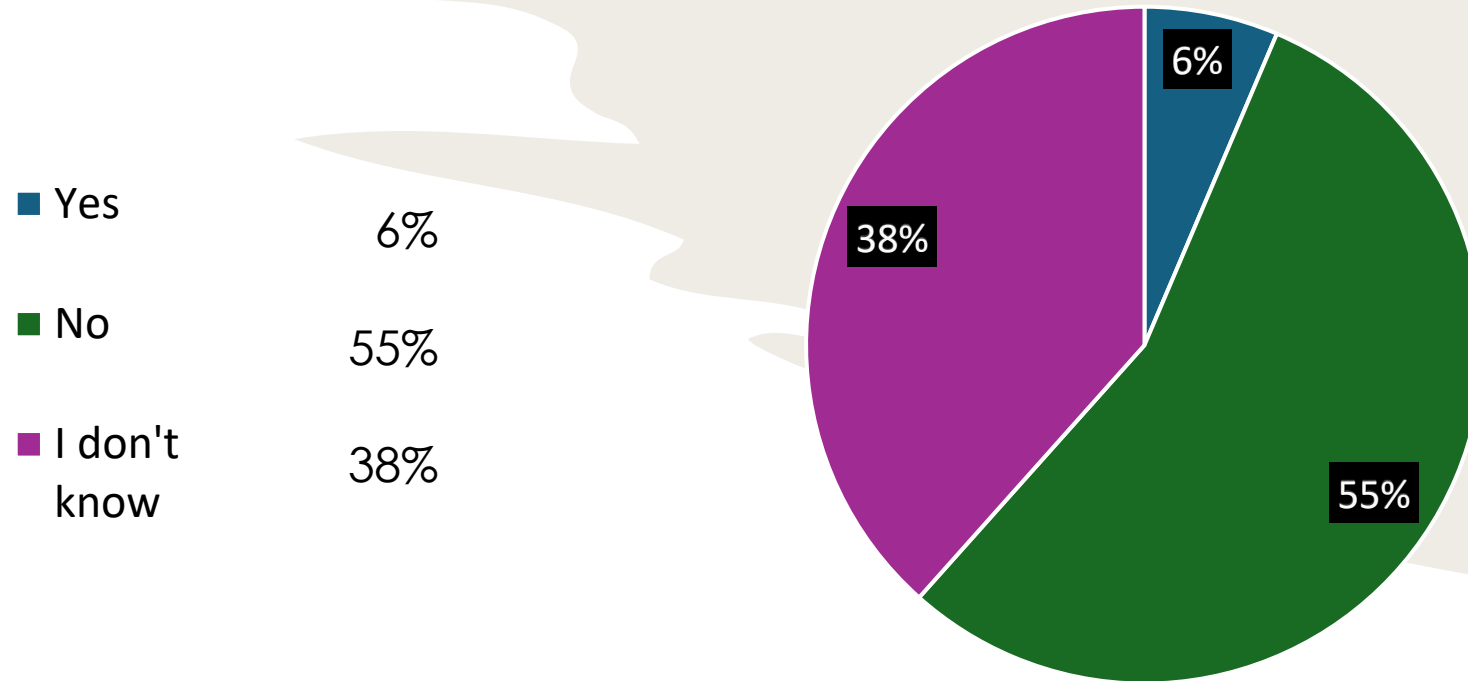
What is the percentage of your mobility students going on blended mobility?



Do you give priority to specific group of students or staff, regarding applications for blended mobility?



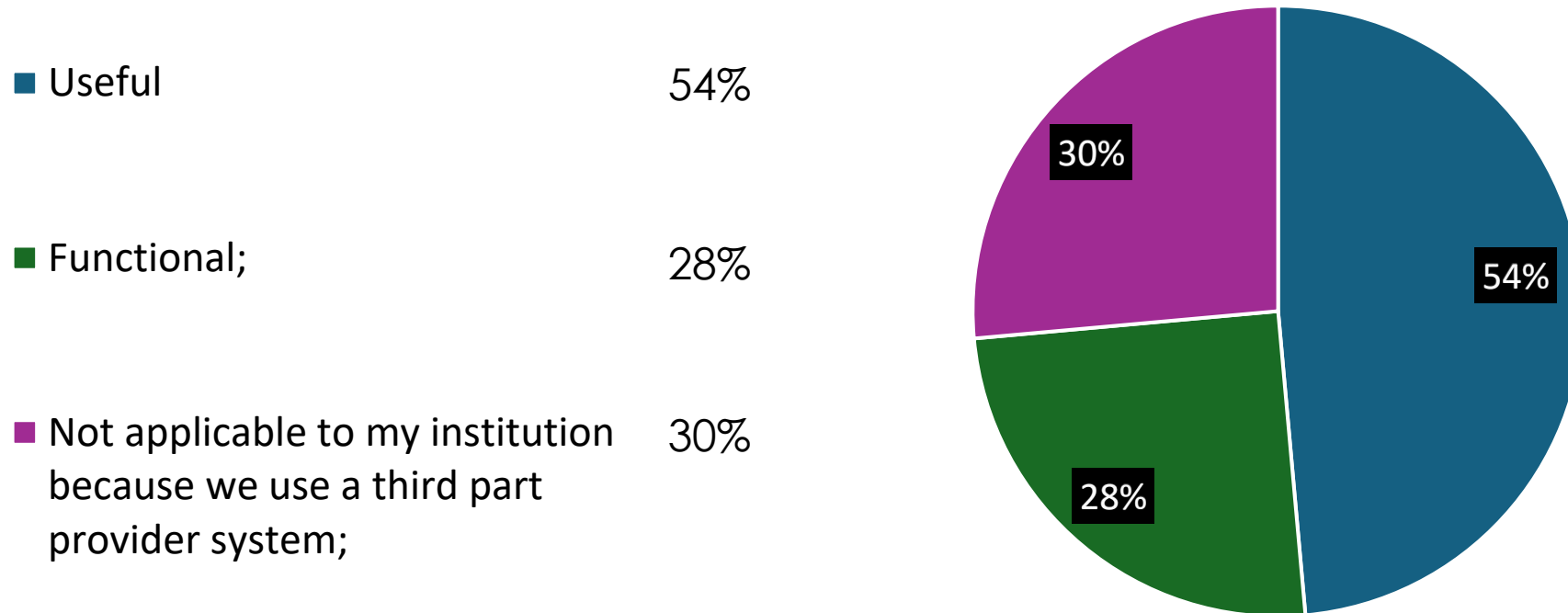
Do you experience any problems with recognition in blended mobility?



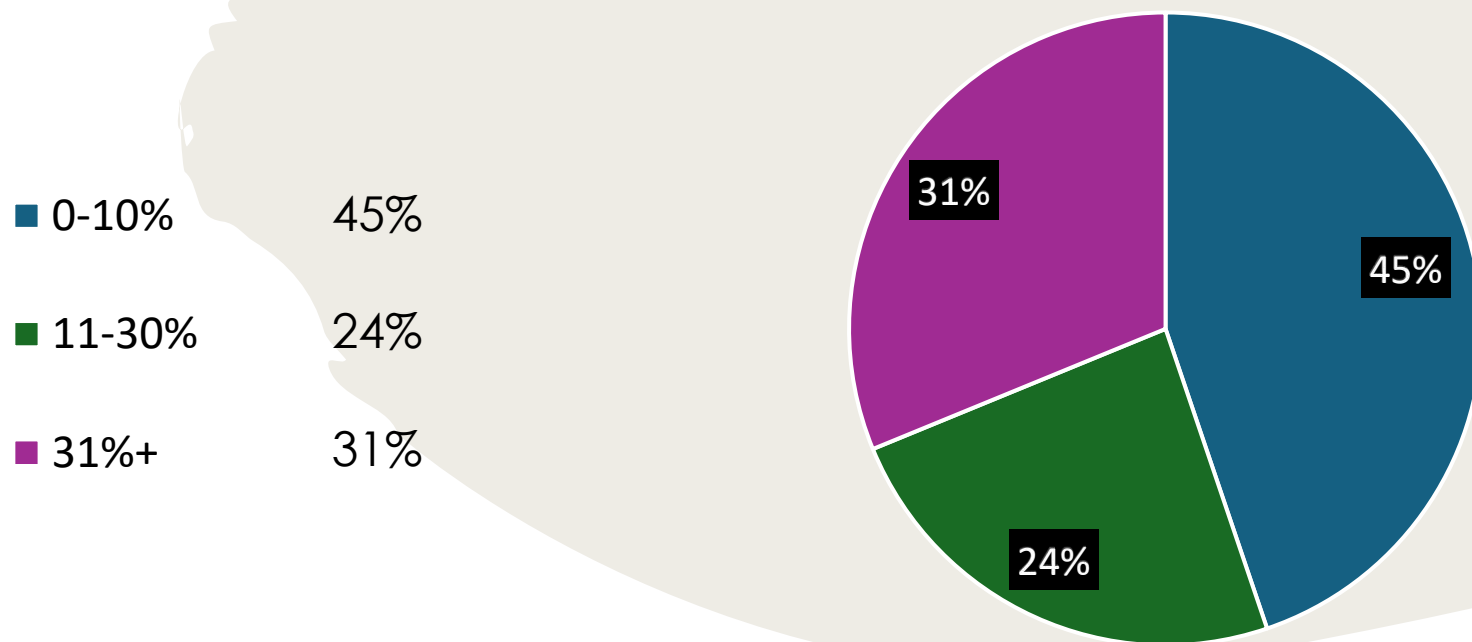

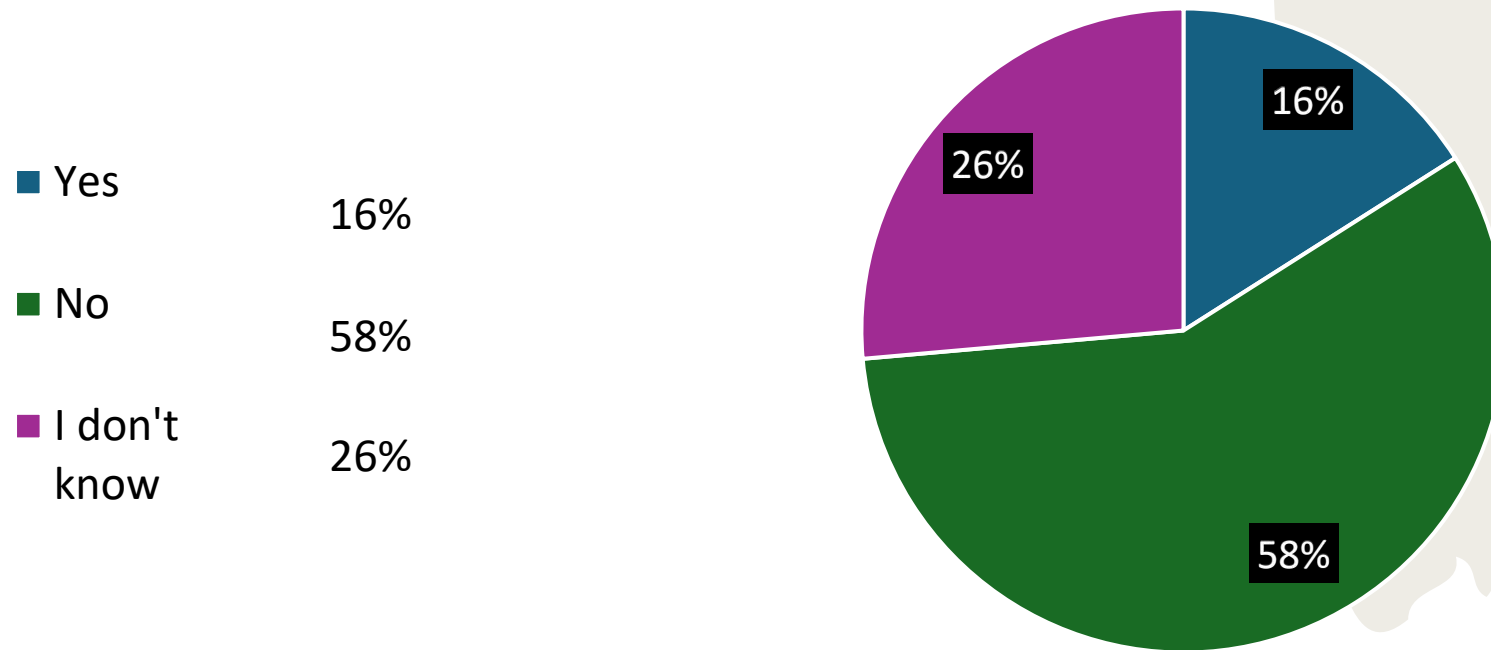
What percentage of your Erasmus+ workload went digital since your university joined the EWP or started using the Erasmus Dashboard or a third-party provider system?



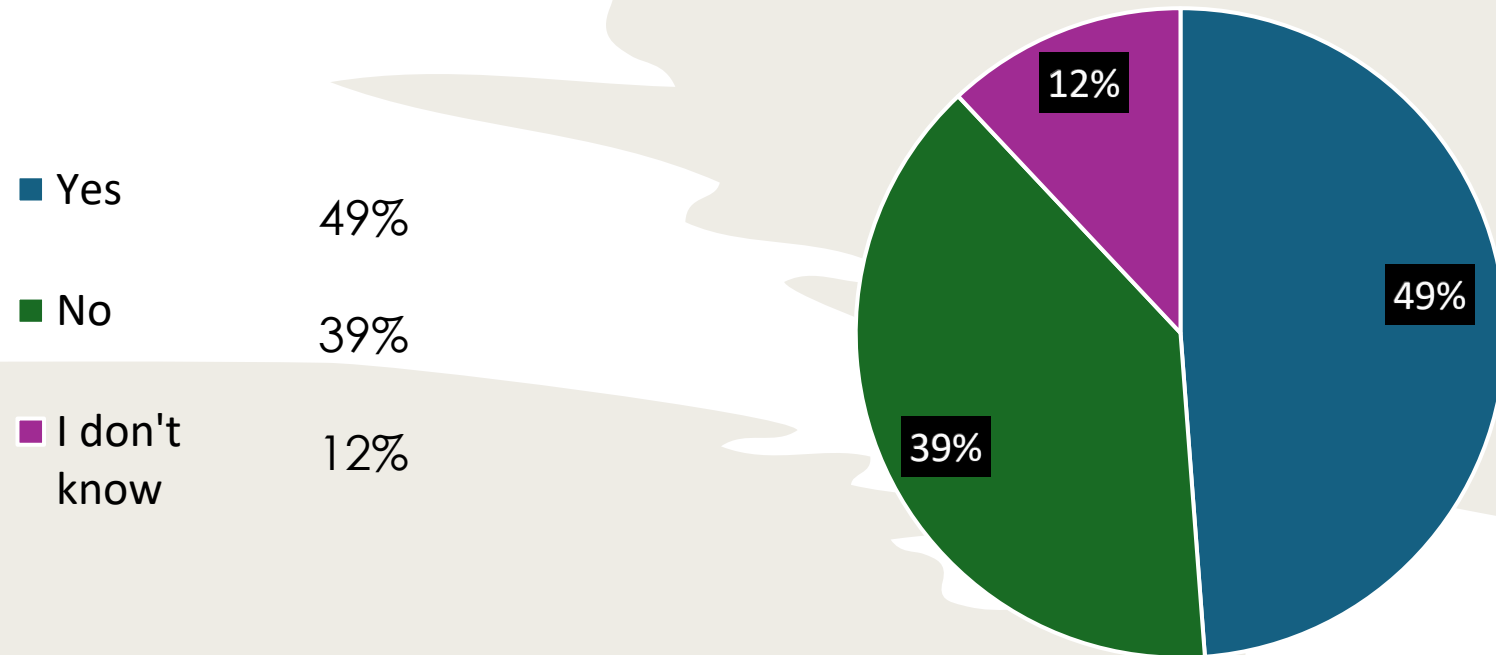
